

RANGAPANI IN RANGAMATI TOWN

Hill cutting, pond filling go on in 'public interest'

A verdant hill at Rangapani in the town is getting levelled as the district administration is using the earth from the hill to fill up a pond.

The work has continued for over three weeks as the site was selected for proposed 'Rangamati Public College' and Bir Bahadur Ushwe Sing, state minister for CHT affairs ministry, laid its foundation stone on May 11 this year.

"No permission was taken from the Department of Environment (DoE) for cutting the hill and filling up the pond. This is a flagrant violation of environmental laws," said Md Zafar Alam, director of DoE, Chittagong.

The pond and surrounding areas at Narkelbagan in the town belongs to Rangamati district scout office but the deputy commissioner (DC), who is also president of the district scout, did not take any opinion from the other members of the body before selecting the site for setting up the public college, said an official seeking anonymity.

Visiting the spot on Friday, this correspondent saw a tractor engaged in

cutting the hill and five to six trucks carrying the earth to fill up the pond at Narkelbagan, the site for the college.

Paban Dey, a staff of the DC office, was overseeing the hill cutting work being done by two local contractors.

Contacted, Rangamati DC Mostafa Kamal requested this correspondent not to file any report about the hill cutting and filling up of the pond.

"The work is being done in public interest. I visited the spot and action will be

taken if anybody is found guilty," he said.

Nikhil Kumar Chakma, chairman of Rangamati Hill District Council, said the district administration is conducting the project. It is being done in the interest of people."

4 women, girl drown in boat capsizes

At least four women and an indigenous girl died in a boat capsized in a waterbody under Phulbaria upazila yesterday afternoon.

The deceased are Rina Akhtar, 28, Shahara Khatun, 26, Sajeda Begum, 25, Rawshan Ara, 24, and indigenous girl Sumitra Sangma, 12. All hailed from Hatilata village in the upazila.

Police and locals said the small country boat sank in Borobeela Beel when the five along with 24 passengers were returning home after collecting VGF rice from Babuganj Bazar in Phulbaria at 1:30pm. Five of them drowned while the others managed to swim ashore, said OC of Phulbaria PS.

HUMAN CHAIN IN PIROJPUR
'Bring killers of NGO official to book'OUR CORRESPONDENT,

A human chain was formed in the district town yesterday, demanding immediate arrest and exemplary punishment of the killers of an official of Proshika, a non-government organisation (NGO).

People from all walks of life including teachers, journalists and politicians joined the programme organised by NGO Forum in the district.

Deceased Bidhan Chandro Roy, 40, of Kalapur upazila, was a field officer at Proshika.

The NGO workers have played the key role to improve the lifestyle of poor people but their lives are now under threat, lamented the participants.

They called upon the authorities concerned to make immediate arrest of the killers and bring them to book.

On July 19, a group of youths, allegedly led by Nayan Hawlader, 23, of Sankarpasha village in Sadar upazila, Al-Amin Mollah, 23, of Umedpur village in Zianagar upazila, Mahmud Hasan Shuvo Khalipha, 19, of Sankarpasha village and Al-Amin, 22, bludgeoned the NGO official, leaving him seriously injured.

The attackers also took away Tk 8,000 from Bidhan and demanded Tk one lakh more as illegal toll.

The following day, critically injured Bidhan died on the way to Barisal Sher-e-Bangla Medical College and Hospital.

Teacher's
body
exhumed

The body of a high school teacher was exhumed on Wednesday after 13 days of its burial in Jagannathpur upazila of Sunamganj.

Zakiganj police exhumed the body of Abdul Karim, an assistant teacher at Swarup Chandra Government High School, in presence of Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) of Zakiganj Titon Khisa following a court order after the sister-in-law of the deceased Rosy Begum filed a murder case with the police station.

Police quoted locals as saying that Karim of Ghechua village died from injuries after he was allegedly beaten to death by his brothers as a sequel to family feud on July 9. His brothers, however, claimed that Karim died of cardiac arrest and buried the body hurriedly without any autopsy.

But police recovered his blood stained shirt from a spot at the village in presence of hundreds of villagers on the same day.

Rosy Begum, wife of Fahim Ahmed, one of the brothers of the deceased lodged a murder case after the burial, accusing 5 people including the two brothers of the dead Abdur Rahim and Shakur Ahmed, said Jamsheed Alam, officer in-charge of Zakiganj Police Station. Police arrested Rahim's wife Shefa Begum.

Agitated locals, students and teachers formed a human chain at Zakiganj and Jagannathpur upazila headquarters, demanding a fair probe into the matter and arrest of the killers.

The exhumed body was sent to Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College Hospital for an autopsy.

BCL leader arrested in
trader abduction caseOUR CORRESPONDENT,

A BCL leader, accused in a case for abduction of a rice trader, was arrested from his house at Mesirpar village in Patgram upazila of the district early yesterday.

The arrestee is Maruf Hossain, 32, general secretary of Patgram union unit of BCL.

Police said local rice trader Jahabul Islam, 32, was picked by a gang led by smuggler Israil Alam Bhuttu from his shop in Mesirpar area on December 25 last year as he was putting pressure on Bhuttu to return Tk

1.5 lakh he borrowed from Jahabul in June the same year.

Jahabul has remained untraced since his abduction.

Victim's wife Amina Begum filed a case with Patgram Police Station on December 27, accusing Bhuttu of Mesirpar village of kidnapping her husband.

Police arrested Bhuttu, 48, at the village on February 25 this year and produced in a court that allowed cops to take him on remand.

Police said Bhutto told them that ex-general secretary of BCL Patgram

upazila unit Mir Russel, Patgram union BCL General Secretary Maruf Hossain and his friend Rakib Hossain were involved in the abduction of Jahabul.

On March 5, police arrested Russel who told police that Maruf and his friend Rakib took away Jahabul and he was not aware of his (Jahabul) whereabouts.

Officer-in Charge Amiruzzaman of Patgram Police station said they have got important information about abducted of rice trader Jahabul, but he refused to disclose anything.
