## Labourer electrocuted in Ctg

A day labourer died after he was electrocuted while working at an under-construction building in Kazir Dewry area of Chittagong city yesterday.

Md Shipon, 26, of Shariatpur was carrying a steel trunk at the building's ground floor when he stumbled and fell on a cable lying on the ground, eyewitnesses said.

He was rushed to Chittagong Medical College Hospital where doctors declared him dead, said police.

## State minister for foreign affairs condoles Chinese quake deaths

declarations and resolutions to drive home NAM's unequivocal stand against Israeli brutalities and breach of international humanitarian principles.

The continued inability of the UN Security Council to impose ceasefire and bring the aggression to a halt should prompt the NAM to consider alternative approaches, including the ones through the UN General Assembly, he said.

The emergency meeting, inaugurated by President of Iran Hassan Rouhani, heard a briefing on the latest situation in Gaza from Palestinian Foreign Minister Riad Al-Maliki.

Ministers from Egypt, South Africa, Algeria, Tunisia, Lebanon, Syria and Venezuela and special representatives from Indonesia, Malaysia, Pakistan, Morocco, Jordan and other NAM member countries also spoke at the meeting.

Bangladesh's Ambassador to Iran Khandakar Abdus Sattar was also present.

Meanwhile, the condemnation of Israeli atrocities continued yesterday with different organisations forming a human chain and holding a rally in Moulvibazar town.

Shishu Kishore Mela and the residents of Kamalganj upazila staged separate protests, urging all peace-loving people to contribute to the independence of Palestine.

# Two Rab men give judicial statement

## Nur Hossain sued for not depositing unlicensed gun

Two members of Rapid Action Battalion yesterday gave judicial statements as witnesses to a Narayanganj court over the abduction and murder of seven people in the district in late April this year.

The court of Senior Judicial Magistrate Monwara Begum recorded the statements of Lance Nayek Md Abdur Razzak and Sepoy Md Azam of Rab-11.

Narayanganj Detective Branch of Police Officer-in-Charge Mamunur Rashid Mondol, also investigation officer of the case, said the two Rab men gave the statement under Section 164 in two cases filed for the murders.

Meanwhile, Shiddirganj Police Station Sub-inspector Azit Mitra yesterday filed a case against Nur Hossain, the key accused in the killings, under the arms act for not depositing his pistol after its licence had been cancelled.

OC Md Ala Uddin said the district administration had asked Nur Hossain to

deposit the gun following the seven murders. Nur Hossain, however, handed over the firearm to his brother-in-law Nur Alam, he added.

On Friday, a train rammed into a car at the capital's Malibagh rail crossing.

Later, from the wreckage of the car police recovered a pistol and police identified that the firearm belonged to Nur Hossain who was arrested in Kolkata of India on June 14.

Seven people including Narayanganj city panel mayor Nazrul Islam and lawyer Chandan Sarker were kidnapped in two separate incidents on April 27 and found dead in the river Shitalakkhya on April 30 and May 1.

Three Rab-11 top officials were fired over their alleged involvement in the incident.

The three ex-Rab officials Lt Col Tarek Syed Mahmud, Maj Arif Hossain and Lt Commander MM Rana were later arrested and placed on remand.

committee, Goyeshwar Chandra Roy, first joint convener Abdul Awal Minto and joint-conveners Kazi Abul Bashar and MA Quaium strongly opposed Soheli.

In the last three days, they held a series of meetings with the BNP chief and expressed their discontent for making Soheli the member secretary. They argued that Soheli was too young for the post.

Apart from other reasons, Abbas and others also argued that senior leaders who were included in the convening committee would feel uneasy to work under Soheli.

In spite of Khaleda's argument that Soheli is an educated and qualified person for the post, Abbas and others remain rigid to their stance.

Against this backdrop, Minto and Goyeshwar proposed that Khaleda lessen the importance of Soheli's post and not give him any signing authority, regarding formation of the complete committee of the Dhaka city BNP.

Khaleda agreed in principle to this end. She will sit formally with the convening committee tonight at her Gulshan office to settle the issue, party sources said.

Khaleda approved the 56-member convening committee of BNP Dhaka city as part of the plan to strengthen and prepare the organisation to wage a tougher anti-government movement in the capital. But the new committee could not start its activities due to serious rift between Abbas and Soheli causing disappointment of party high-ups.

## Iranian parliamentary team meets Speaker

The visiting Iranian parliamentary delegation met Speaker Dr Shirin Sharmin Chaudhury at the latter's parliament office yesterday.

Fateme Rahbar, head of the Iran Parliamentary Fraction of Women and Family, led the six-member team.

At the meeting, Speaker Shirin Sharmin Chaudhury said Bangladesh had made a remarkable progress in women empowerment and gender equity as the leader of the House, the speaker, the leader of the opposition and deputy leader of the House are women.

Fateme Rahbar said the development Bangladesh achieved in women empowerment was praiseworthy.

She said a committee had been formed in Iranian parliament to deepen Iran-Bangladesh relations and the speaker of Iranian Parliament would visit Bangladesh soon.

About women development in Iran, the head of the Iran Parliamentary Fraction of Women and Family said Iranian women were ahead in education, health, agriculture and research. "Women's participation in higher education is 60 percent."

The Iranian parliamentary team arrived in Dhaka on Sunday on a five-day visit.

The other members of the delegation are Nayereh Akhavan Bitaraf, MP, Shahla Mirgali Bayat, MP, Sakineh Omrani, MP, representative of Foreign Office of Iran Hamidreza Soltanpour and Protocol Expert Jalal Aboul Hassani, according to a handout.
