of schedules will open on August 11 and 12 respectively.

The DSCC earned Tk 6.23 crore from 10 cattle markets, while the DNCC earned Tk 6.88 crore from nine markets in 2013.

"We have a target to earn more money from the cattle markets this year, for which we will go for re-tenders if we don't get satisfactory offers," said Md Aminul Islam, chief estate officer of the DNCC, adding that they had already published the date of two re-tenders in the tender notice.

Aminul said they were keeping tender boxes in seven places--the commissioner's office of Dhaka division, chief estate officer's office of the DNCC at Banani, and five zonal offices of the DNCC, to ensure participation of all.

Chief estate officer of the DSCC, Khalid Ahmed, said they would also go for re-tenders if they did not get satisfactory offers. Sources of both the city corporations said a section of the ruling party men every year created syndicates to take lease of the cattle markets at lower prices, and this year these men were also active.

The amount of Hasil (charge that buyers pay on the purchasing price) will remain same like previous year. Last year, the Hasil was Tk 50 against every Tk 1,000.

The other cattle markets of DSCC are Jhigatola-Hazaribagh ground, Rahmatganj playground, Meradiya Bazar Khilgaon, Sadeque Hossain Khoka playground, Adarsha School field and its adjoining DCC's open space at Golapbagh, Armanitola playground, Moitri Shangha playground adjoining Uttar Shajahanpur Khilgaon Rail Gate Bazar, Dhupkhola East and Club field, Balurmath adjoining Brothers Union Club in Gopibagh, open space adjoining Postogola crematorium, and Bangladesh Math.

Under DNCC, the markets will be set up at Uttara Azampur Government Primary School field, open space at Khilkhet Banorupa residential project, open space in Agargaon slum, open space adjoining Banani Railway Station, playground of Agargaon slum, open space of Eastern Housing, playground of Polytechnic Institute, open space of adjoining bypass road of J block of Baridhara, and open space adjoining Uttara Sector 11 and 13.

imprisonment for their roles and involvement in the carnage. It also handed down rigorous imprisonment, ranging from three to 10 years, to another 256 people, mostly BDR jawans. The court acquitted remaining 277 accused. A total of 846 people, 823 of them BDR members, stood the trial.

Ashish said Mohiuddin Ahmed, assistant director, and Jahangir Hossain Bhuiyan, traffic inspector, of BIWTA, and Md Muinuddin Julfikar, surveyor, and Shafiq Aiyub, inspector, of the Department of Shipping (DOS), showed wanton negligence.

Contacted, BIWTA's Mohiuddin said, "I am not responsible for ensuring safe voyage, marine safety. It was traffic inspector Jahangir Hossain."

Khandaker told The Daily Star on Monday that no marine safety and traffic inspector of BIWTA was present, when the vessel departed Kawrakandi.

DOS Chief Inspector Shafiqur Rahman said though it was the duty of Shafiq Aiyub to oversee vessel safety both at Dhaka and Mawa ports, Aiyub was at Dhaka considering priority. DOS's Muinuddin was not available for

response. Speaking on the occasion, Dr Abdur

Rahim, a former naval architecture professor at Buet, said hundreds of committees had been formed to investigate sinking of launches but none was meant for finding the real BIWTA Chairman Samsuddoha cause. Those were for mere eyewash, he said.

A Supreme Court lawyer, Sadia Arman said the Pinak-6 disaster manifested absolutely the organisational failure o BIWTA and DOS.

Hill Tracts Peace Accord in 1997, but could not manage to build a home there until recently, she said.

The BGB battalion headquarters is being built on 29.81 acres of land where the decades-old Baghaichhari Government Primary School (No 2) is located.

As the entire area is fenced off with barbed wire now, the school has become inaccessible for students, many of

whom are from the evicted families, said Shudarshana. The members of the parliamentary caucus on indigenous peoples visited the area on July 14. Asked for comments, Fazle Hossain Badsha, the caucus convener, said he asked the local administration and government representatives to

"find a peaceful and humane solution" to the crisis. Md Masud Karim, the deputy commissioner of Khagrachhari, however, said, "We tried to rehabilitate them elsewhere but they refused and wanted that same land

back... They are not willing to cooperate in negotiations."

# RU indigenous

They demanded formation of a separate land commission for the indigenous communities.

The communities played a vital role in different crucial movements, including the 1952 Language Movement and 1971 Liberation War, they said.

Although the indigenous people contribute a lot to the national economy, they are deprived of their rights, they alleged.

Earlier on Monday, the indigenous woman, also a Union Parishad member, was beaten up and raped by 30-35 people when she refused them to pay an extortion money of Tk 3 lakh while she was working at her paddy field, claimed the victim.


