# Put sanctions on Israel

## Protesters in Dhaka urge international community

Different cultural and student organisations yesterday called on the global community to step forward to immediately stop Israel's "genocidal atrocities" in Gaza.

Under the banner of "Gono-Adhikar Sangram Committee", activists of the organisations brought out a procession before the capital's National Museum and were headed towards the US embassy, but police resisted them at Shahbagh intersection.

The protesters then held a rally there, in which Jahid Hasan Mahmud, a professor of applied physics at Dhaka University, said, "Israel has been committing war crimes and has grossly violated international laws. The masterminds behind the atrocities should be tried in an international court."

The US is backing the "genocide" through continuous military and economic support for its "imperial ambitions" in the energy-rich regions of the Middle East, he added.

The ongoing "genocide" proves that it is not a war against Hamas; in fact it is against all Palestinian citizens, Jahid asserted.

Masud Khan, a leader of Gono-Adhikar Gonomancha, said, "Silence is a war crime too. The world leaders should impose tough sanctions against Israel."

Demanding that the Bangladeshi government take immediate diplomatic steps to halt the brutal attacks, he urged all progressive forces to stage demonstrations against Israel.

The protesters also burnt effigies of US President Barack Obama and Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu.

Nine Bangladeshis were killed after being caught up in clashes in Tripoli and Benghazi between June 21 and August 6.

Last month, the bodies of two brothers Swapna Miah, 34, and Milon Sayal, 32, of Shariatpur, were sent back. No decision has yet been made regarding the other body, he added.



University organised the seminar, "Global Maritime Challenges and Role of Maritime Higher Education in Bangladesh", where its website [www.bsmrmu.edu.bd](http://www.bsmrmu.edu.bd) was launched.

The university will start its academic session in next January. The area for building its campus has not been fixed yet.

Nahid said there were only 12 universities in the world like this one.

Bangladesh has achieved vast swathes of areas and huge resources in the Bay of Bengal after winning two verdicts—one against India and the other against Myanmar—in international courts but the country has to use the resources properly, he said.

"We have to boost our knowledge, skills and ramp up research on this. This university has opened a window of opportunities for all this," he said.

Real Admiral ASM Abdul Baten, the vice chancellor of BSMRMU, said the university was now at its formative stage, and they would gradually build it into a centre for excellence of maritime education.

The specialised institution will run both graduate and postgraduate programmes across a wide range of disciplines, he said.

The proposed areas of study include maritime governance and policy, shipping administration, earth and ocean science, maritime engineering and technology, and maritime business administration.

Rinnet, a second-year student of management and information studies, passed lewd remarks to the two female students when they were sitting with Ifti at Media Chatter around 3:30pm.

They beat up Ifti with scrapped wood before some of his friends rescued him and took him to Rajshahi University Medical Centre, they said.

He was shifted to RMCH, as the wounds were severe.

One of the two female students, who are juniors at Ifti's department, told The Daily Star that four to five men harassed them, and when Ifti protested, he was attacked.

Both Shusmoy and Rinnet denied the allegations of the harassment and attack.
