

Ribery ends int'l career

 France winger Franck Ribery is ending his career with the national team to focus on his club and family, the player, who missed this year's World Cup through injury, said on Wednesday.

"I am stopping," the 31-year-old told German magazine Kicker in an interview to be published on Thursday. "I realised that this moment has come."

Ribery, a 2006 World Cup finalist who was Europe's player of the year in 2013, said he wanted to make way for a younger generation of players.

"I want to focus on my family and fully concentrate on my work at Bayern Munich and make way in the national team for the many young and exciting players," he said.

The Frenchman has been playing club football at Bayern Munich since 2007 and won a treble of domestic and European titles in 2013.

"One has to know when to stop. I have experienced so much and now is the time for others to come forward. You could see at the World Cup that we should have no concerns about France's future."

Ribery, who won 81 caps and scored 16 international goals since making his debut for France in 2006, battled to be fit for the World Cup but despite intensive treatment he failed to make it to Brazil, where France lost to Germany in the quarterfinals.

Chess queen quits

Hungarian Grand Master Judit Polgar, widely recognised as the greatest female chess player of all time, said Wednesday she is retiring from competition to dedicate more time to her family and chess foundation.

The 38-year-old, who has been the top-ranked female player for 25 years, told The Times newspaper she no longer had the concentration levels required and railed against the sexism she experienced during her career.

She recalled how one coach told her she was "an exception, not a girl" and that there was the general impression among the leading players that "there were men, women and Judit Polgar".

Asked if there was a female world champion on the horizon, she replied: "I hope in the next 20 years. But I'm not sure she's been born yet."

The eight-time "Chess Oscar" winner also criticised today's game for being obsessed with technology, saying that "so many competitions are driven by who has the best computer".

Polgar, who is currently competing for the Hungarian team at the Chess Olympiad in Norway, credits her career on an "educational research project" carried out by her father Laszlo.

He pulled Judit and her two sisters Susan and Sofia out of school, deciding that their lives "would be a living example, that would prove that any healthy child -- if taught early and intensively -- can be brought up to be exceptionally successful in any field".

She won her first international chess tournament at nine and was only 12 when she teamed up with her sisters to claim Hungary's first-ever women's Olympic gold chess medal.

At the age of 15, Polgar broke Bobby Fischer's record by becoming the youngest ever international chess grandmaster, and reached a high of eighth in the World Men's Rating List in 2005.

She is now married with a son and daughter, aged 10 and eight, and set up the Judit Polgar Chess Foundation for Educational Benefits in 2012.

Super Cup Dortmund's

 Borussia Dortmund eased past lacklustre Bayern Munich 2-0 with goals from Henrikh Mkhitaryan and Pierre-Emerick Aubameyang to lift the German Super Cup on Wednesday and draw first blood in their rivalry with the Bavarians this season.

Both clubs left most of their World Cup winners and big names at home or on the bench with the season yet to start and Dortmund were more aggressive from the start despite most eyes on Bayern's new striker Robert Lewandowski.

"We played very good at the back," Dortmund coach Juergen Klopp told reporters.

"The Bavarians did not have a lot of chances and we defended superbly. The engine is gradually starting to work well but we are still not at 100 percent."

With Dortmund fans whistling and jeering the club's former forward on his first return to the city since joining their rivals, Armenian Mkhitaryan struck in the 23rd minute, rifling home

after a superb run.

Bayern, without Franck Ribery and Arjen Robben as well as defender Rafinha and midfielders Bastian Schweinsteiger and Thiago Alcantara, were on the back foot throughout with keeper Manuel Neuer, newly crowned German Player of the Year, repeatedly coming to the rescue.

He was without a chance, however, when winger Aubameyang rose high above defender Jerome Boateng to drill in a header in the 62nd minute and celebrate by putting on a Spiderman mask he slipped out of his sock to the delight of the 80,600 crowd.

Aubameyang and Italy striker Ciro Immobile played in a two-pronged attack as Dortmund did not look to be missing Lewandowski on Wednesday, despite being without central defender and new captain Mats Hummels and winger Marco Reus.

Defender Sokratis Papastathopoulos also managed to shut out Lewandowski, who had only one clear scoring chance.

"I only focused on the game but Dortmund were better than us," Lewandowski, last season's Bundesliga top scorer, told reporters.

"It is always a bit difficult when many players come later into training but we will improve a lot in the next game."

Bayern's new-look three-man backline also played below expectations as the Ruhr valley club players continuously found space.

Bayern coach Pep Guardiola brought on captain Philipp Lahm and Mario Goetze in the second half but Germany's World Cup winners could do little to stem the flow of the Dortmund attacks.

There was more bad news for Bayern with midfielder Javi Martinez being taken off after half an hour with a suspected knee ligament injury.

"Many of us only recently returned to training and we also have some players injured," said Lahm. "It was not easy. We did not have that many chances but we are still in the middle of our pre-season preparations."

The hosts had chances to add to their tally en route to retaining the trophy, with last season's double winners Bayern, who also lost the Super Cup 12 months ago, looking more like a work in progress with the league start just over a week away.

Spain gain a place

Spain move up one place to seventh alongside Brazil in the latest FIFA world rankings in the only movement in the top 10.

World Cup winners Germany still top the list, ahead of beaten finalists Argentina, in the August 14 rankings.

Costa Rica, who reached the World Cup quarter-finals, move up a place to 15th, their highest ranking since the classification began in 1993.

Suarez ban upheld

Uruguay forward Luis Suarez's four-month playing ban for biting Italy defender Giorgio Chiellini has been upheld by the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) but he can now train with his new club Barcelona, CAS said on Thursday.

Suarez remains ineligible to play in official matches during the four-month period, and his nine-match international ban remains in place, but Suarez's legal team said that they had successfully argued that FIFA had misapplied its own rules when considering the case and the sanction it imposed on other football-related activities was disproportionate.

"As a result, Suarez is now permitted to train and attend matches with his Barcelona team mates in preparation for the new season," his lawyers said in a statement.


