Man shot, robbed of Tk 30 lakh

Muggers shot a man and took away Tk 30 lakh from him in broad daylight in the capital's Mirpur-2 yesterday.

With chest injuries, Mujibur Rahman, 40, a land broker, was immediately taken to Dhaka Medical College Hospital from where he was transferred to the National Institute of Diseases of the Chest and Hospital.

Around 4:00pm, Mujibur and his cousin Anayet Khan were walking towards a nearby bus stand to go to Khilkhet, Anayet told reporters at DMCH.

Suddenly, two youths appeared there. One snatched Mujibur's bag containing the money while another pointed a firearm at his chest. Within a few seconds, the armed mugger shot him, he said. Locals started shouting while the culprits hurriedly ran to another accomplice who was waiting with a motorcycle near the spot, he said, adding that later they sped away towards Mirpur-1.

Mohammad Shakhawat Hossain, assistant commissioner of Mirpur Zone of Dhaka Metropolitan Police, said they were investigating the incident.

"We are constantly getting telephone calls at our embassy from people willing to donate money and medicines for the people of Gaza," he said.

He also thanked Hasina for taking a bold stand on the Palestinian issue and raising voice against the supporters of Israel.

"I want to tell you something which nobody can do it in an Eid day. The great Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina asked me about the situation in Gaza. She said we don't blame Israel, we blame America," the envoy said, reports UNB.

He said US Ambassador Dan Mozena was beside him when he was briefing Hasina on Gaza.

Quoting Hasina, the diplomat said they (Bangladeshis) blamed America because they supported Israel, but US envoy opposed it saying "no no".

"Then the prime minister said, yes, this is the truth; we don't blame Israel, we blame the great supporters of Israel," Shaher quoted Hasina as saying.

Appreciating Hasina's stance, the diplomat said, "You can't find a leader in the world who directly speaks up against America in such way."

Since July 8, the Israeli offensive has killed more than 2,000 Palestinians, mostly civilians and children.

5,000 workers between April last year and July this year.

After today's discussion, a bigger target will be set, said the secretary. The meeting will focus on sending domestic helps because the demand for them is increasing in that country, he said.

Few Bangladeshi workers are being sent to Malaysia nowadays. Only 6,520 female workers have migrated in the last seven years since 2007, according to the Bureau of Manpower, Employment and Training.

Prof Tasneem Siddiqui, founder chairperson of RMMRU, which is working for

migrants' rights, said, "I think the government should find an alternative mechanism to send workers, as the G-to-G process has proved unsuccessful. The recruiting agencies can be directly involved in the process after giving strict conditions to them."

Manpower export to Malaysia had been banned for around four years from 2009, due to anomalies in the recruitment process by private recruiting agencies. The ban was withdrawn in 2012 before the two governments signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU).

Around five lakh Bangladeshis are currently working in Malaysia.
