KILLING OF 3 LAW ENFORCERS IN MONGLA

6 robbers to die, 7 others get life

A court here yesterday sentenced six robbers to death and seven others to life imprisonment for killing three law enforcers during a raid in the Passur River in Mongla upazila of the district in 2006.

The six, who have been given death penalty, are Rafiqul Islam Sheikh, Kuddus Sheikh, Idris Sheikh and Babul Sheikh of Morrelganj upazila under Bagerhat district; and Alkas Fakir and Ilias Sheikh of Batiaghata upazila under Khulna district. They were tried in absentia.

The lifers are Reazul Sheikh, Akram Sheikh, Alam Sheikh, Badsha Sheikh, Jamal Sheikh, Kamal alias Sumon Sheikh of Morrelganj upazila; and Aslam Sheikh of Batiaghata upazila. Of them, Jamal Sheikh and Badsha Sheikh were arrested during investigation of the case. They later gave confessional statements before the court.

District and Sessions Judge SM Solaiman also acquitted two others as charges brought against them could not be proved. They are Nanna Sheikh and Mizanur Rahman of Hogaldanga village in Batiaghata upazila of Khulna.

According to the prosecution, a joint team of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab)-6 and coastguards of Mongla (West Zone), acting

on a tip-off, launched a drive in Passur River on December 1, 2006 to arrest a gang of 15 to 20 robbers who were taking preparations for committing robberies there.

As Rab and coastguards challenged the bandits, they opened fire, prompting the law enforcers to retaliate. At one stage, three members of the joint team boarded the boat of the robbers and locked in a scuffle with the gang members.

During the scuffle, coastguard members MH Kabir and MA Islam and Rab platoon commander Kanchan fell into the river and went missing. The robbers jumped into the river and managed to flee. Bodies of the law enforcers were recovered from the river the following day.

Deputy Additional Director (DAD) of Rab-6 Mohsin Ali filed a murder case with Mongla Police Station, accusing some unidentified people on the day.

On May 8, 2007, Sub-Inspector Nasir Uddin, also the investigation officer of the case, pressed charges against 15 people.

After examining documents and witnesses, Judge SM Solaiman of the District and Sessions Judge's Court pronounced the verdict. The court recorded statements of 11 prosecution witnesses during the trial of the case.

Journo stabbed in Barisal

Pulok Chatterjee, 50, Barisal bureau chief of national Bangla daily Samakal and secretary of Barisal Press Club, was severely stabbed by criminals early yesterday.

Biswapati Chatterjee, father of victim said Pulok, after returning home from his workplace called his wife over mobile phone for opening the gate of his house adjacent to Government Barisal College at North Mallik Bari of Kalibari Road area in the city at about 1:15am.

Pulak was stabbed six

times in different parts of the body. He is now out of danger, said Dr Jahirul Islam Manik at Sher-e-Bangla Medical College Hospital (SBMCH).

Sub Inspector Mohiuddin of Barisal Kotwali Police Station said, they detained Subal Mukharjee, brother of divorced wife of Pulok, from the hospital premises at night on suspicion. Police believed that the matter was a sequel to family feud.

Police recovered a sharp-weapon from in front of Pulok's house.

"streamers," for the smoke plume that comes from birds that ignite in midair.

Federal wildlife investigators who visited the BrightSource Energy plant last year and watched as birds burned and fell, reporting an average of one "streamer" every two minutes, are urging California officials to halt the operator's application to build a still-bigger version.

The investigators want the halt until the full extent of the deaths can be assessed. Estimates per year now range from a low of about a thousand by BrightSource to 28,000 by an expert for the Center for Biological Diversity environmental group.

The deaths are "alarming. It's hard to say whether that's the location or the technology," said Garry George, renewable-energy director for the California chapter of the Audubon Society. "There needs to be some caution."

The bird kills mark the latest instance in which the quest for clean energy sometimes has inadvertent environmental harm. Solar farms have been criticized for their impacts on desert tortoises, and wind farms have killed birds, including numerous raptors.

"We take this issue very seriously," said Jeff Holland, a spokesman for NRG Solar of Carlsbad, California, the second of the three companies behind the plant. The third, Google, deferred comment to its partners.

The \$2.2 billion plant, which launched in February, is at Ivanpah Dry Lake near the California-Nevada border. The operator says it's the world's biggest plant to employ so-called power towers.

Housewife brutally stabbed for dowry

A mother of two is groaning in severe pain at Dinajpur Medical College Hospital as she was brutally stabbed allegedly by her husband for dowry, about a week ago.

Hapless Mukti Begum, 31, is daughter of late Nur Islam of Beltola-Islambagh village in Sadar upazila.

Arafat Hossain, a cousin of the victim filed a case with Dinajpur Sadar Police Station accusing her husband Nazrul Islam on August 17, said Md Altaf Hossain, officer-in-charge of the police station.

Arafat said, Mukti was married off to Nazrul, a day labourer of Chandganj village of the upazila in 1999. Her husband used to torture her physically and mentally for dowry since her marriage.

Around two years ago, Nazrul told Mukti to bring Tk 1 lakh as dowry from her widowed mother. As she refused to do so, Nazrul beat her mercilessly. Mukti fled the house and took shelter at her paternal home.

On August 12, at around 9:00pm, Nazrul along with his aides went to Mukti's parental home and demanded the money saying he would marry another woman if she did not comply with his demand. But Mukti turned it down again and asked him to leave at once.

Enraged, Nazrul started stabbing her indiscriminately in front of her family members with a kitchen knife and fled the scene hurriedly.

Doctors at the hospital said, stab injury marks were found on different parts of her body, including her entire face.

Hearing on clearing Limon's case deferred

The hearing aimed at clearing Limon from charges in a case filed for 'obstructing Rab from public duty' was deferred on Monday as the judge concerned was not available in the court.

Limon's lawyer Manik Acharjee further said that the home ministry had directed to exempt Limon from the case last year.

With this, the date for

hearing in the case was changed for the ninth time on Monday and the next date was fixed on September 30, said Manik.

In 2011, the elite force filed two cases with Rajapur police station against Limon- one for possessing arms while the other for obstructing them from public duty.

Limon has already been cleared in the arms case, following a direction of home ministry.
