## Tragic!

Cameroonian football player Albert Ebosse died Saturday after he was hit by a projectile thrown from the stands following his team's loss in the Algerian football championship, APS news agency reported.

Ebosse, who was 24, was declared dead after he was rushed to a hospital at Tizi Ouzou, east of the capital Algiers, where the match took place.

He scored the lone goal for his club JS Kabylie in the home match in what turned out to be a 2-1 defeat against USM Alger, on the second day of the tournament.

Fans had started throwing objects from the stands inside the Tizi Ouzou stadium after the match as the players were returning to their changing room. Ebosse joined JS Kabylie

in 2013, and was best scorer in the 2013-2014 championship.

The Algerian interior ministry ordered an investigation to search for the culprit.

Meanwhile, the Confederation of African Football (CAF) have called for "exemplary sanctions" following the death of Ebosse.

### Mercury to rise at the Etihad

Manchester City and Liverpool will renew their rivalry beneath the Etihad Stadium floodlights on Monday in the first major head-to-head encounter of the fledgling Premier League season.

When the teams last met, at Anfield in April, a late Philippe Coutinho goal gave Liverpool a 3-2 victory that left them on course for a first league title since 1990.

But with the finishing line in sight, Brendan Rodgers's side collapsed, allowing City to creep up on the rails and pip them to the title by two points.

Liverpool's late-season slump was particularly traumatic for captain Steven Gerrard, whose slip against Chelsea allowed Demba Ba to score a goal that allowed City back into the title race.

### Bolt skips Zurich meet

Usain Bolt has pulled out of the Weltklasse Diamond League meeting in Zurich on Thursday, organisers have announced.

The Jamaican, who clocked 9.98sec in Warsaw on Saturday night in only his second individual race of an injury-hampered season, has opted to bring an early end to his campaign. Zurich had been his last scheduled competition.

A statement from the organisers said Bolt's coach, Glen Mills, was satisfied with the sprinter's performances on his comeback from the foot injury which had delayed his start to the season, but "feels it is now time to shut it down while he is healthy and injury free with a view on his preparations for the 2015 season".

The world's fastest man has competed only four times in 2014, twice at the Commonwealth Games in Glasgow as he anchored Jamaica to 4x100m relay gold, on the Copacabana beach in Rio de Janeiro in the Mano a Manorace where he won in 10.06sec and then in Warsaw, where his time was an unofficial world best for an indoor

## Di Maria exit imminent

Argentine midfielder Angel di Maria's expected move to Manchester United should be completed in the coming days, Real Madrid boss Carlo Ancelotti confirmed on Sunday.

Di Maria had previously expressed his desire to leave the European champions before the end of the transfer window and he is on the verge of a move to United.

However, the Old Trafford club is facing a significant price tag if it is to secure the signature of the 26-year-old winger. Madrid is aiming to receive somewhere

in the region of 80 million to 90 million euros for Di Maria, though the initial fee paid by United could be lower with bonuses and add-ons supplementing the deal.

Di Maria, meanwhile, could pocket a 6 million euro signing-on fee and sign a five-year contract worth close to the 375,000 euros a week earned by Wayne Rooney.

"Di Maria hasn't trained, it is not official but the transfer is very close," Ancelotti said ahead of his side's La Liga opener against Cordoba on Monday.

"I thank him for what he has given this club. Personally I had a fantastic relationship with him and he did great work for this

"It was his decision. The club has done everything possible to make him stay. I wish him luck.

Di Maria was the man-of-the-match as Real claimed their 10th European Cup with a 4-1 win over Atletico Madrid back in May to cap a fine season.

Ancelotti insisted, though, that Sami Khedira will not be leaving over the next week despite having under 12 months left on his contract.

"He is happy and he will stay. He is very important for the team."


