### Jamaat ameer arrested

Police on Tuesday arrested two top leaders of the district unit of Jamaat-e-Islami from their residences in Rahmannagar area of the town. They face two cases filed for vandalism, arson attacks and carrying out subversive activities. The arrestees are-- Abdul Haque Sarakr, 56, principal of Muruil Fazil Madrasa and Nayeab-e-ameer of the district unit and Advocate Riaz Uddin, 55, assistant secretary of the unit. AHM Foyzur Rahman, officer in-charge of Sadar Police Station, said the arrestees were produced before a court in the afternoon which sent them to jail.

### Two journalists sent to jail

A court here on Tuesday sent two local journalists to jail after they were held on charge of demanding Tk one lakh illegal toll from a listed contractor of LGED. Aminul Islam, younger brother of Monirul Islam, a Class I contractor of the city filed the case with District and Session Judge's Court against Ziaul Hasan Palash, local correspondent of Channel-24 and Dainik Samakal, and Dulal Saha, correspondent of Jamuna TV on July 7. According to the case statement, they demanded Tk one lakh illegal toll from Monirul Islam threatening him to write a report about the alleged corruption he did during the construction work of some bridges and culvers in the district financed by the LGED in 2007-08 fiscal years.

### "Punish Hridoy's killers"

Students of Government Ashek Mahmud College brought out a procession in the district town on Tuesday demanding capital punishment to the killers of Azharul Islam Hridoy, a B. Com first year student of the college, who was found murdered on August 17. According to the case statement, Hridoy along with his three friends-- Nishat, Konok, and Hasan-- went to the bank of Brahmaputra River on two motorbikes on August 16, where the trio killed Hridoy and threw his body in the water. When Hridoy's family members put pressure on the trio to know about his whereabouts, they told them that he had drowned in the river. Police recovered the body on the following day. Faruk Ratan, father of the deceased filed a murder case with the Sadar police station on August 17, accusing Nishat, Konok and Hasan in this connection.

### Man killed by siblings

A youth died at Rangpur Medical College Hospital on Tuesday after being stabbed allegedly by his two elder brothers at Kashdaha village in Sunderganj upazila. The deceased is Bablu Mia, 24. Locals said, there had been a long standing dispute between Bablu Mia and his two elder brothers Aminul Islam and Monu Mia over sharing of their ancestral property. On Monday night, Aminul and Monu waylaid Bablu and stabbed him indiscriminately while he was returning home from Mia Bazaar. Hearing his screams, locals rescued him and rushed him to Sunderganj Upazila Health Complex. Meanwhile, as Bablu's body reached his village, aggrieved locals caught the two accused and handed them over to the police.

### MOTORBIKE RIDES FOR RENT

## A way to live with dignity

As many as 1300 people are engaged in providing motorcycle rides to people for rent in different areas of the district.

The provision, introduced a couple of years ago, has made communication especially in rural areas easy while a large number of youths, many of them earlier engaged in anti-social activities, have changed their life through the trade.

"Returning home after losing everything abroad two years ago, I took an illegal job in Dhaka for maintaining my family. Now I am living with dig-

nity, earning by giving motorbike rides for rent," said Jahangir of Galua in Rajapur upazila.

"The work earns me Tk 600 to 1,000 daily," said a motorbike rider in Jhalakathi town, who was earlier known as a local delinquent.

"I attend my classes in morning and earn by giving motorbike rides in the afternoon. It helps to maintain my study expenditure as well as bear the cost of treatment of my sick father," said Nayeem, a student of Suhrawardy College, Pirojpur.

Introduction of motorbike rides for rent has made communication in rural areas easy as village roads are not suit-

able for most other vehicles, said Moniruzzaman, chairman of Rajapur upazila parishad.

Several bike riders, however, alleged harassment by policemen on roads.

Md Majid Ali, superintendent of police of Jhalakathi, said law enforcers have to stop and check the rented bikes to prevent their use for criminal purposes.

"A good number of unemployed youths are now self employed with bike riding. However, they need to proper training for smooth and safe movement with passengers," said Mizanur Rahaman, assistant director of Youth Development Centre, Jhalakathi.

### 3 fishermen rescued from den of abductors

Coast Guard officials rescued three fishermen from their abductors' den at Kader-Khal in the Sundarbans on Sunday.

The rescued three are Nazrul Islam, 32, Saiful Islam, 18, and Mamun Miah, 16.

All of them hail from Horintana village in Patharghata upazila in Barguna district.

Operation staff officer Lieutenant Commander Alauddin of West Mongla Coast Guard Zone said, a gang of robbers kidnapped the fishermen two days ago while they were preparing for fishing.

Later they kept the fishermen confined to their den for ransom.

Tipped off, Coast Guard raided in the area and rescued the fishermen.

The rescued three were sent to a local hospital.

However, the robber gang members managed to flee the scene.

### UP chairman sued on graft charge

The chairman and the secretary of Rangabali Union Parishad (UP) under the newly formed Rangabali upazila of the district have been sued on charge of misappropriating Tk 1.52 crore of different development projects.

Md Mostafizur Rahman, a member of the UP, filed a case with a Patuakhali court on Sunday, accusing Chairman Md Nazrul Islam and Secretary Md Zakir Hossain.

Sessions and Special Judge Satendra Nath Ghosh took the case into cognisance and asked the Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) to take necessary steps against the accused after proper investigation.

In the case statement, the complainant stated that UP Nazrul Islam and Secretary Zakir Hossain misappropriated Tk 1.52 crore of different development projects in the union from January 2011 to June 2014. But he mentioned the names of only three projects.

He alleged that both chairman and secretary embezzled Tk 10.94 lakh without doing work under Local Government Support Project (LGSP), Tk 6 lakh by selling 30 tonnes of TR rice allocated for renovation of Uttarpara Jame Mosque, and Tk 10 lakh in the name of development of Baherchar Bazar.

## 11 missing as trawlers sink in two rivers

At least 10 people went missing when a trawler capsized in the Meghna near Bhairab Bhairab upazila of the district yesterday.

The identity of the deceased, however, could not be known till filing of this report around 7:30pm.

The vessel was carrying at least 35 people to Nabinagar upazila of Brahmanbaria from Bhairab Bazar of the district, said Badrul Alam, officer in-charge of Bhairab Police Station.

The trawler capsized around 3:00pm. Most of its other passengers, however swam ashore.

On information, a fire-

fighting unit from of Bhairab rushed to the spot and started a search operation to rescue the missing people.

After the incident, police detained two staff of the vessel—Shahin and Zahid -- for carrying passengers more than the capacity.

Away in Pabna, a man went missing when a sand-laden trawler capsized in Boral River near Bhangur upazila yesterday, reports our Pabna correspondent.

The victim is Abdul Alim, 35, of Ratanpur village in Faridpur upazila of the district.

Police said, a sand-laden trawler with 10 passengers on board capsized in the river around 3:30pm. Alim went missing while nine other passengers could swim ashore.

## Three housewives killed for dowry

Three housewives have been murdered allegedly by their husbands over dowry in Pabna, Manikganj and Sirajganj districts.

A housewife was killed allegedly by her husband for dowry at village Darinaricha in Iswardi upazila of Pabna early Tuesday, reports our correspondent.

Deceased Farhana Akter Eva, 22, wife of Shaon Hossain of the village was often tortured for refusing to bring dowry money from her parents, locals said.

Recently Shaon started forcing Farhana to bring Tk 2 lakh dowry for business, said Md. Rakibul Islam, uncle of the deceased. Failing to get the money Shaon strangled her, he added.

Shaon was arrested in connection with the incident, said police.

In Manikganj, a pregnant woman was killed alleged by her husband for dowry at Athalia village under Singair upazila early Monday.

She was identified as Rokeya Akter, 25, wife of Uzzal Hossain of the village, reports our correspondent.

Elder sister of the deceased Farzana Akter said, Uzzal beat up Rokeya at around 12:30am after a feud over dowry issue. Rokeya was not taken to hospital

but given treatment by a village doctor, she said. Rokeya succumbed to her injuries at around 2:00am.

Uzzal married Rokeya eight months ago. After their marriage, Uzzal demanded dowry money from Rokeya's family. Her family gave Tk. 40,000 to Uzzal a day after the Eid-ul-Fitr, Farzana said, adding that he demanded Tk. 3 lakh as dowry. He often beat up her for the dowry, she said.

In Sirajganj, a housewife was stabbed to death allegedly by her husband over dowry at Ultra Hajipur village in Raiganj upazila early Sunday reports UNB. The deceased was identified as Munni Khatun, 25, mother of one child and wife of Shariful Islam, a resident of the same village.

Rashedul Islam Biswas, officer in-charge of Raiganj Police Station, said Munni was married to Shariful about four years back. Shariful received a dowry of Tk one lakh from Munni's family at the time of marriage.

Recently, he raised a demand for more dowry money and as Munni's parents failed to meet the demand, he started to torture his wife.

On Saturday night, Shariful hacked Munni indiscriminately, leaving her dead on the spot and fled the scene.
