

13 illegal passport brokers jailed

A mobile court backed by Rab arrested 13 illegal passport brokers near the passport office in the capital and jailed them for three months each yesterday.

They are Alamgir, Mintu, Mahbub Alam, Nazrul Islam, Tipu Munshi, Azam Mandol, Saddam Sardar, Alamgir, Din Islam, Abdur Rahim, Nur Jahan, Nasima and Rozina.

Despite warnings from the authority, they had been taking money from people promising them to earn passport in the shortest time without police verification, Rab officials said.

Around 40 to 45 such brokers usually run their illegal activities in front of the passport office everyday, they added.

Following the incident, police filed a case against several hundred people including the two.

In its closing arguments, the prosecution has prayed to the tribunal that Azharul be given the capital punishment for crimes against humanity and genocide and also fined for causing damage to a rape victim during the war.

The defence counsel said that if his client was given "capital punishment or imprisonment", then fine or reparation would not apply. "Either he will be fined or given other punishment, including the capital punishment or imprisonment, that will curtail his liberty," Shishir said.

The counsel also argued over hearsay evidence, saying the evidence lost its weight or "probative values" when hearsay witnesses gave contradictory testimonies. Shishir then cited the testimonies of two prosecution witnesses to show contradictions.

The proceeding was adjourned until today.

Azharul, facing six charges, was produced before the tribunal. Nineteen prosecution witnesses testified against the Jamaat assistant secretary general.

This transition will be carried out in three phases. Decisions on settlement (phase 1) and points based system (phase 2) applications are already being made in New Delhi. The third and final phase will see all other visa application categories submitted on or after September 7 being assessed in New Delhi from that date.

"The cost of the service will stay the same and we will continue to operate within our existing service standards of 15 working days for non-settlement cases and 60 working days for settlement cases," it said.

As usual, Bangladeshis will submit their visa applications at Visa Application Centres in Dhaka and Sylhet. There will be no need for applicants to travel to India. Nor should they notice any difference to the quality or speed of our service, it said.

Smuggled gold recovered in capital

Customs and railway police officials in separate drives arrested one person and recovered a total of 5.75kg of gold, worth around TK 2.85 crore, in the capital's Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport and Kamalapur Railway Station yesterday.

Customs officials said they recovered 4.5kgs of gold rods hidden inside the handle of an abandoned trolley bag at a green channel while the officials were checking luggage of passengers of a Fly Dubai flight.

Meanwhile, Dhaka Railway police detained Sujon alias Babar after recovering 10 gold bars, weighing over 1.25kgs, from his pants soon after he got off Turna Nishitha Express.

the future.

Later, they decided to create a public space, where it would be kept for the public to see what critical situation of Bangladesh's roads and highways have created, she added.

"It was our responsibility as an artist," said the filmmaker, hoping that the art would create awareness among people.

"It is a change that must begin with awareness and knowledge to action," she said, explaining why DU campus was chosen for the installation.

Another survivor, artist Dhali Al Mamoon, who conceived the idea and installed the memorial artwork, described how difficult it was for him to come out of the memory while working on it. "I was often devastated with grief," he said.

"There is a lack of civic sense among us," said Asif Munier, brother of Mishuk Munier, adding that many educated people did not follow traffic rules while crossing roads or driving. He suggested that artworks promoting awareness could be installed on roads.

Inaugurating the installation, Vice Chancellor of DU AAMS Arefin Siddique hoped that such steps would help create awareness and reduce the rate of accidents.

The landscape of the installation, funded by Brac and Brac Bank Ltd, was designed by architect Salauddin Ahmed. Tareque Masud Memorial Trust coordinated the project.

Brac founder Sir Fazle Hasan Abed, although not present on the occasion as the guest of honour, sent a message to the audience, in which he termed the deaths from road accidents unacceptable.

His message, read by Brac official Asif Saleh, mentioned that research showed that out of the 21,635km of roads, 80 percent of accidents happen on 57km. So road accidents can be avoided if this span of the road can be managed properly, he read.

About maintenance of the installation, artist Mamoon, said he had his trust in people that they would be respectful to the cause it represented. "Besides, we are discussing how the installation can be maintained," he said.

the involvement of the three in the murder of Faruqi, chief imam of the Supreme Court Jame Masjid. He said though police could not yet unearth any clue into the murder, they have been working on various possible motives.

Faisal Faruqi, slain Nurul Islam's son and also the complainant of the murder case, told The Daily Star that a team of DB police visited their Rajabazar house, the crime spot, and talked to them about the murder.

Police and Faruqi's family members have been suspecting the dispute with rival religious groups, which were opposed to his beliefs, as the reason behind the killing.

ADC Ashique said police are hopeful of arresting the persons involved in the killing soon.

Unidentified criminals slit the throat of Faruqi, also a presidium member of the Islamic Front Bangladesh and a presenter of Islamic programmes in two private television channels, at his East Rajabazar house in the capital on Wednesday night.
