Aid for 15 'fake' FFs stopped

Amtali upazila administration under Barguna district has stopped payment of allowance to 15 'fake' freedom fighters as the upazila Muktijoddha Sangsad recently brought certificate forgery charges against them.

Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Md Mizanur Rahman said the monthly honorarium of the freedom fighters has been stopped as per directive of the deputy commissioner.

"I have already asked the upazila social welfare officer to investigate the allegation brought by the upazila Muktijoddha Sangsad. If their certificates are proved to be false, these will be cancelled," The UNO said.

The 'fake' freedom fighters are

Shamsuddin Ahmed, former upazila Awami League general secretary, Md Sekander Ali, Ali Akbar, Nurul Haque, Kanchon Ali Khan, Abul Hossain Mridha, Abdul Malek, Abdul Mannan Mia, Nurul Islam, Md Shahjahan, ATM Rafiqul Islam, Momin Uddin, Habibur Rahman, Monsur Ahmed and Abul Hossain.

The upazila Muktijoddha Sangsad recently brought allegation of forgery for obtaining fake freedom fighters' certificate against the 15 and urged the ministry concerned, the deputy commissioner and the upazila nirbahi officer to cancel the certificates.

Dewan Mujibur Rahman, deputy commander of Amtali Muktijoddha command, said they took the decision to lodge complaints against the 15 'fake'

freedom fighters in a meeting held on July 7 with Upazila Commander GM Delwar Hossain in the chair.

"They neither fought nor received any training in freedom fighters' camps during the Liberation War. They didn't even help any freedom fighters. But they are enjoying all government facilities," said Upazila Commander GM Delwar Hossain.

Raja Oliul Haque, a freedom fighter (Mukibarta no 0601020074), also submitted a written complaint to the ministry concerned, the deputy commissioner and the upazila nirbahi officer recently, demanding cancellation of certificates of 15 'fake' freedom fighter in the upazila.

He also demanded legal action against the 'fake' FFs.

Three held on charge of killing newborn

Police arrested three people including a couple at Hatatpara village in Sadar upazila on Wednesday on charge of killing a newborn on July 24.

The arrestees are father of the newborn Ismail Hossain Babu, 33, his mother Rima Begum, 24, and grandmother Ashia Begum, 55, of the village.

The couple has a 10-year-old son and three-year-old daughter, said Jasimuddin, officer in-charge of Sadar Model police station, adding that Rima gave birth to another son on July 21.

On July 24, locals found the body of the newborn floating in a local pond and informed the police who sent it to Chapainawabganj Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Following an unnatural death case filed by police, the deceased's parents and maternal grandmother Semali Begum were arrested but they were later released on bail.

On Wednesday evening, after getting the autopsy report stating the newborn strangled, police arrested Babu, Rima and Ashia.

Sub-inspector Golam Mostofa filed a murder case against the trio in this connection, said the OC.

Four geckos seized in Sylhet, three arrested

Police in separate drives arrested three people and recovered four geckos, a lizard type creature locally known as 'takshak', from Humayun Rashid Chatter and Hazrat Shahjalal Dargah Gate areas in South Surma upazila on Wednesday night.

The arrestees were identified as Manir Uddin, 60, a resident of Dharakul village in Companiganj upazila of Noakhali district, and Abdul Majid, 48, and Julhas Miah, 48, both residents of Mullapara village in Panchhari upazila of Khagrachhari district.

Police said, acting on a tip-off, a team of police arrested Majid and Julhas from Humayun Rashid Chatter area at about 9:30 pm when they have just sold the four geckos to Manir.

Acting on the confessional statement of the arrestees, police conducted another drive in Hazrat Shahjalal Dargah Gate area in the city and arrested Manir at night.

Police also recovered the four geckos from his possession.

Majid and Julhas brought the geckos from Khagrachhari in the evening, police said.

The market value of the geckos would be Tk1.5 crore.

BSF detains youth

Indian Border Security Force (BSF) picked up a Bangladeshi youth from Chospara border in Baliadangi upazila yesterday on charge of illegal intrusion.

The detainee is Md Mannan, 24, son of Md Islam Uddin of the village.

Lt Col Kamal Ahmed, commanding officer of BGB 30 Battalion, told this correspondent over cell phone that a BSF patrol team from of Chaklagach Camp picked up Mannan from inside the Indian territory around 1:30pm while he was returning to Bangladesh.

BGB sources said, in reply to a BGB letter, BSF said they had already handed over the youth to the Indian police.

Orphan 'raped' at staff quarters of orphanage

An orphan girl was raped allegedly by a youth at the staff quarters of Government Shishu Paribar (orphanage) in Balatarai area in the town on Sunday morning.

Victim's sister Ameena Begum lodged a case with Sadar Police Station on Wednesday night, accusing three people.

The accused are Acting Assistant Superintendent of the government-run orphanage Ismat Ara Parvin Reshma, 28, her husband Nawshad Ali, 37, and alleged rapist Alhaz Miah alias Ashique, 22.

Having the girl in the trap of love, Ashique took her from the orphanage to his elder sister Reshma's staff quarters in the compound

on Sunday morning and raped her, police quoted the complainant as saying.

Contacted, Reshma said her younger brother Ashique was in love with the girl, also a second year student of Lalmonirhat Government College, and met her at her official residence on Sunday morning. "I knew nothing about the alleged rape," she said.

Abdul Motalib, superintendent of the orphanage, said the district administration and the social welfare department are investigating the incident.

As many as 130 orphan daughters from different areas of the district are now staying at the Govt Shishu Paribar and they all are students of different schools and colleges in the town, the superintendent said.
