Intern assaults nurse

Victim's colleagues go on strike; attacker suspended; protesters to stop work for 5hrs a day for 3 days

Healthcare services at Sir Salimullah Medical College and Mitford Hospital halted yesterday as the nurses observed a sudden work abstention after one of their colleagues was assaulted allegedly by an intern. The agitating nurses said they would continue observing

work abstention from 8:00am to 1:00pm for three days from today to press home their demand for arrest of the intern and cancellation of his registration.

They threatened to observe indefinite work abstention if their demand was not met within the three days.

Injured Bokul Rani Das, a senior staff nurse, was treated at the hospital, while the hospital authorities suspended intern Rakibul Islam Sujon.

The incident occurred over a trifle matter of giving saline to a patient at the hospital's obstetrics and gynaecology department where both worked, said witnesses.

They said Rakibul had asked Bokul to give intravenous

saline to a patient, but Bokul said she would do it after finishing what she had been doing at the time. The intern then verbally abused her leading to an alterca-

tion between them. At one stage, Rakibul dragged Bokul to another room and beat her mercilessly, they added. Brig Gen Md Zakir Hassan, director of the hospital, said the

administration formed a four-member committee to look into the matter, adding that a meeting between the administration and the nurses decided that the nurses would render their services should an emergency situation arise at the hospital.

RU flouts own order

Allows suspended, demoted BCL leader Tuhin to take exam

SM Touhid-Al-Hossain Tuhin, the former general secretary of Bangladesh Chhatra League at Rajshahi University, was suspended from the university for an unspecified period for beating up an official late last month but he appeared at his fourth-year viva-voce yesterday. The test was taken in secret, official sources told The Daily Star.

On August 28, Tuhin and BCL vice president of RU unit Tanmoy Ananda Avi led their followers into the vice chancellor's office and beat up the university's acting chief engineer, Sirajum Munir, there, as he refused to "pay Tk 1 lakh as extortion money".

The BCL central committee removed Tuhin as general secretary of unit a day later, while RU authorities suspended three BCL leaders including Tuhin on August 30.

Registrar Prof Entajul Haque also filed an extortion case against Tuhin and other BCL men the same day.

Sources at the finance and banking department where Tuhin is enrolled said Tuhin attended the viva voce though he could not take part in any academic activities for being suspended.

Amzad Hossain, chairman of the department, said they did not get any copy of the suspension order from the registrar's office yet; so they allowed him to appear at the vivavoce. He said they would cancel Tuhin's exam if the authorities directed them to do so.

The registrar said the suspension order was not published, as an investigation was underway in this regard. The notice will be sent to the department immediately, he added.

Vice Chancellor Prof Muhammad Mizanuddin said, "We will look into how he could appear at the viva voce."

Drug Peddling, Assault on Cops 7 AL men sent to jail

A Barisal court yesterday sent seven ruling Awami League men, including one ward-level leader, to jail after police filed two cases against them and six other activists on charges of assaults on cops and drug peddling.

The seven were arrested on Friday night in Bhatikhana

Gauasar area of Barisal city. Sub-inspector Shahin, complainant of the two cases,

said a police patrol team primarily arrested four with hemp, but when they were taking them to Kawnia Police Station, some activists led by Murad Hossain Rintu, general secretary of ward-4 unit of the AL, arrived there, assaulted cops, and tried to snatch the detainees. Police then called in reinforcement and rounded up the seven including Rintu.

The four accused in the drug case are Salahuddin Khan, Mehedi Hasan, Mustafijur Rahman and Wahid Hossain, while the nine men accused of assaulting police are Rintu, Shafikul Islam Nannu, AK Azad Mia, Tofel Mia, Sohel Akon, Rajib, Shamim, Alamin and Shahid.

Three cases filed against them, three others released

Dhaka University authorities yesterday sued four out of the seven admission seekers who were caught with answers to the test questions in the inbox of their mobile phones during the "Ga" unit admission test.

As of filing the report at 8:00pm, the authorities filed three cases against the four admission seekers, while the other three were released on Friday. The four in jail are Ahadur Rahman, Nurul Afsar, Mehedi Hasan and Ershad Haque. DU acting Proctor Prof Amzad Ali said they were prepar-

ing to file cases against the other three as well.

Faisal Kabir, who sat for the exam in Badrunnesa Government Girls' College, was released from the centre.

Prof Amzad Ali claimed that they handed Faisal over to the college authorities and on duty Chawkbazar police with evidence.

However, Azizur Rahman, officer-in-charge of the police station, claimed he knew nothing of the incident.

While another admission seeker, Arifur Rahman, was taken to Kalabagan Police Station and released from there. Contacted, Md Iqbal, officer-in-charge of the police

station, claimed they freed Arif as the university authorities did not contact them. Contradicting the OC's statement, Prof Amzad alleged two university teachers handed over Arif to the police station.

Similarly, Sanjana Binte Bashir was freed only after giving an undertaking. After being caught at Burhanuddin College, Sanjana was

taken to the university where she gave an undertaking and then was released.


