Ribery issue resolved

Bayern Munich CEO Karl-Heinz Rummenigge insists that row over Franck Ribery's international retirement has been "all but settled".

UEFA president Michel Platini claimed on Sunday that the French winger would be hit with a threegame suspension for his club side if he refused a call-up from Les Bleus boss Didier Deschamps.


However, Rummenigge insists that Ribery has already been given permission to bring the curtain down on his international career.

"It is all but settled," the Bayern chief told Bild. "As Philipp Lahm has discussed his international retirement with [Germany coach Joachim] Low, Franck has indeed discussed his with Deschamps

"He will still not being called up anymore [despite Platini's threat]. Everything is in order and FIFAcompliant."

Platini had argued that players do not have the right to choose whether they represent their country.

"Franck Ribery cannot simply decide whether he plays for France or not," the former Bleus ace told Bild am Sonntag.

Simple for Simone City's loss is others' gain

Simone Zaza made the most of the suspended Mario Balotelli's absence up front by scoring the opening goal to pave the way for Italy's

comfortable 2-0 win over Norway in a Euro 2016 Group H qualifier on Tuesday.

The Sassuolo striker, surprisingly brought into the squad by new coach Antonio Conte, struck with a deflected shot after 16 minutes and also hit the crossbar and had an another effort cleared off the line before being substituted.

The 23-year-old Zaza repaid Conte's faith immediately, winning a penalty on his debut in the 2-0 friendly victory over Netherlands in Bari on Thursday before scoring in Oslo. "He is a player of great desire and pride

and he and the others have given a good example of that tonight," Conte told a news conference. The Norwegians offered little resistance,

enjoying plenty of possession in front of a sell-out crowd but failing to threaten Gianluigi Buffon's goal. Their best attacks came down Italy's left

flank as livewire Mats Moeller Daehli displayed his full bag of tricks and dribbles but the winger faded in the second half, as did the home team's chances.

Missing Balotelli and playmaker Andrea Pirlo, Conte's first competitive game in charge saw him field a relatively young team that favoured industry over flair.

With Mattia De Sciglio and Matteo Darmian playing wide in a five-man midfield, Italy began by probing the spaces behind Norway's full backs.

Conte's team defended from the front, with Zaza and Ciro Immobile energetically leading the chase to win the ball back when their side gave it away.

The visitors took the lead fortuitously when Zaza's effort took a deflection and wrong-footed keeper Orjan Nyland before bouncing into the net.

Norway's defence was too passive for the goal and should have shut down the Italy striker before he shot.

Captain Leonardo Bonucci again punished Norway in the 62nd minute, rising unmarked to power home a downward header from substitute Manuel Pasqual's cross.

Italy could have made it 3-0 in the 77th minute when Zaza went one-on-one with Nyland but his rising shot cannoned back off the crossbar and Alessandro Florenzi's header from the rebound was palmed away by the keeper.

Zaza had another one-on-one with Nyland a few minutes later. This time his delicate chip was cleared off the line and he was replaced by Mattia Destro soon after.

Conte said his side played an "almost perfect game", adding "it's important to create that kind of team spirit, a team with a capital T".

"It has been a dream week for me," said Zaza. "Now my objective is to keep my place in the team. The work of a striker is tiring, but if you want to play in this side you need to run."

It was the perfect start to the qualifying campaign for Italy, and one that sets them up nicely for a double-header at home to Azerbaijan and away to Malta next month before a stiffer test in Croatia in November.

Per-Mathias Hogmo's Norway, meanwhile, will hope to bounce back when they face Malta and Bulgaria next month.

Manchester City's huge fine for breaching UEFA's financial fair play rules is to be shared out around the other clubs in the Champions League.

City were fined £50million for the FFP breaches but will only have to pay around £20million if they comply with the breakeven rules in future seasons.

The first tranche of payments from City, Paris St Germain and Zenit St Petersburg will total £20million and will be split among the Champions League and Europa League clubs who did comply with the rules last season.

A similar sum will be distributed to clubs who comply with the FFP rules in this season's European competitions.

European Clubs' Association chairman Karl-Heinz Rummenigge said UEFA had agreed the fines should go to the other clubs.

He told a news conference in Geneva: 'It was an agreement between UEFA and the clubs that it was money belonging to the clubs.'

The clubs will have a chance to argue any changes to FFP rules at a meeting with UEFA on October 13.

Brazil win again

Brazil beat Ecuador 1-0 in an international friendly in New Jersey on Tuesday with a first half goal from Willian enough to give coach Dunga his second successive victory.

The win came four days after Brazil beat Colombia and the win over a sprightly Ecuador side delighted the new manager.

"There weren't any negative points," he told reporters. "You have to take positives from the negatives. You learn, you evolve. So for me it was all positive."

Brazil's winner came on the half-hour from a well-rehearsed free kick. Oscar hit a short pass to Neymar who lifted a curled pass into the net with the outside of his right foot.

Ecuador almost equalised six minutes later but Enner Valencia's right foot shot hit the base of the post after beating goalkeeper Jefferson.

Brazil's best chance of the second half fell to Neymar in the 47th minute but the Barcelona striker missed an open goal from four yards out with the keeper on the ground.

Although Brazil were not at their best, the two wins buoyed those players trying to impress the new coach.

MU declare record revenue

Despite their on-pitch travails last season, Manchester United on Wednesday announced a 19 percent rise in annual revenue to a record £433.2 million (\$698.8 million, 539.6 million euros).

United floundered in their first season after the retirement of long-serving manager Alex Ferguson, finishing seventh in the Premier League and sacking his successor, David Moyes, but they continued to thrive commercially.

The club reported a 49 percent increase in sponsorship revenue -- helped by a blockbuster £750 million 10-year deal with Adidas -- and recorded a profit of £23.9 million.

"We are very proud of the results achieved in fiscal year 2014 as we once again generated record revenues," said executive vice-chairman Ed

Woodward in a statement. "With Louis van Gaal at the helm as manager, and the recent signing of some of the world's leading players to further strengthen our squad, we are very excited about the future and believe it's the start of a new chapter in the club's history.

"Louis's footballing philosophy fits very well with Manchester United and he has an impressive track record of success throughout his career, winning league titles with every club he has managed." Partly due to their non-

participation in the Champions League, United expect their income to fall to between £385 million and £395 million over the course of the current season. But they invested

around £150 million on new players during the close-season transfer window, including a Britishrecord £59.7 million swoop for Argentina international winger Angel di Maria.

The figures released on Wednesday also revealed that United paid out £5.2 million in compensation to former Everton manager Moyes, who was dismissed in April, and some members of his coaching staff.

Barcelona's Uruguay forward Luis Suarez can make his debut in the La Liga 'Clasico' at Real Madrid on Oct. 25, the day after a FIFA ban for biting an opponent at the World Cup ends, the club said on Wednesday.

Spain's professional league (LFP) had earlier confirmed the date of the game, the first meeting of the bitter rivals since Real beat Barca 1-0 in last season's King's Cup final.

"Luis Suarez will be able to play in the 'Clasico' at the Santiago Bernabeu on Oct. 25," Barcelona said on their website.

"The Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) confirmed to FC Barcelona that the Uruguayan forward's sanction expires the day before.'

Bale gets Wales out of trouble

Andorra -- who had not won in 51 competitive fixtures since beating Macedonia in October 2004 -- had taken a shock lead early in the qualifying Group B encounter in Andorra la Vella as Ildefons Lima converted a sixth-minute penalty after Neil Taylor pulled back Ivan Lorenzo.

It was Lima's eighth international goal and ended an Andorran goal drought in competitive matches stretching back 18 games. The Welsh found it difficult coping with the physical


game of their hosts but Bale finally got them on level terms with a header in the 22nd minute. However, if the Welsh fans thought that would ease their
