

BLASTS AT INU'S HOUSE JCD chief among five charged

COURT CORRESPONDENT

A Dhaka court yesterday framed charges against five Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal men including its chief in a case filed for blasting bombs at the information minister's residence in June last year.

The accused are JCD President Abdul Kader Bhuiyan Jewel; Dhaka city (north) Senior Vice-president Sharifuddin Jewel; central committee member Akil Mahmud; Mirpur thana unit Senior Vice-president Firoz Mahmud; and Titumir College unit activist Mahbubul Alam.

Another accused Moshir Rahman, a DMCH physician, remains absconding since filing of the case. On August 27, Moshir escaped from the dock of the court after he heard that his bail was rejected.

On November 16, 2011, the Anti-Corruption Commission filed the case bringing allegation that a group of DMCH staff purchased 7,409 ampoules of drug at a price higher than the market rate, causing a loss of over Tk 2.31 crore to the state coffers between July 2009 and June 2010.

COX'S BAZAR

HC directs govt to stop hill cutting

The High Court yesterday directed the government to immediately stop cutting and destroying hills at Jhilonza Mouza in Cox's Bazar.

In response to a petition filed by Bangladesh Environmental Lawyers' Association (Bela) on Monday, the court ordered the administration to take legal actions against those responsible for damaging the hills.

The HC bench of Justice Moyeenul Islam Chowdhury and Justice Ashraf Kamal directed the authorities to submit a report before it in two months after complying with the order.

The bench also issued a rule asking the government to explain in three weeks as to why its inaction to prevent cutting and damaging hill should not be declared illegal and why they should not be directed to declare the area as ecologically critical.

In 2011, the Department of Environment fined Uttaran Grihayan Somobay Samiti, a private company, Tk 2.86 crore for illegally cutting the hills, measuring 87.10 acres, and damaging the environment, said Bela.

stoppage, one hour every day, in protest of the attack concluded yesterday. Cuta may announce further programmes today.

In a separate drive, police recovered 18 petrol bombs, five crackers, 1.5kg of gunpowder, one machete, three knives, 40 iron rods, four litres of petrol, and some documents containing Shibir's plans for destructive activities at Shaheed Abdur Rab hall, said Mohammad Shahidullah, additional superintendent of police, Chittagong (north zone).

Fourteen rooms where alleged Shibir activists reside were raided, he said.

Shibir enforced an indefinite strike at CU on August 31, demanding reopening of Shah Amanat and Suhrawardy halls, both shut since August 24 following clashes between Shibir and Bangladesh Chhatra League. The two dorms were reportedly dominated by Shibir.

During their strike, Shibir allegedly attacked at least four teachers' buses, bombed rail stations twice, and set fire to rail tracks. The student body has always denied the allegations.

WAR CRIMES CONVICT SC scraps dead Alim's appeal

Three workers were killed and two others injured when a covered van ploughed through an automobile workshop beside Dhaka-Khulna highway at Maksudpur College intersection in Gopalganj district yesterday after its driver lost control over the vehicle, reports our Gopalganj correspondent.

Nur Alam Mollah, 32, of Lohachura village and Sabuj Mollah, 22, died instantly while Rahim Sheikh, 27, of Kamalapur village succumbed to his injuries on the way to Dhaka.

The injured were admitted to a hospital in critical conditions.

Protesting the incident, locals blocked the highway for one and a half hours.
