## Family seeks justice for custodial death of Bangladeshi in UK

The family members of a Bangladeshi, who died in an immigration detention centre in the UK on September 5, yesterday demanded justice and return of the body home. They also demanded proper investigation of the cause behind his death. They raised the demands at a human chain formed in front of Central Shaheed Minar in Sylhet under the banner of Shacheton Nagorik Samaj.

## HC rejects Oli's challenge against ACC's demand for wealth info

The High Court yesterday rejected a writ petition filed by Liberal Democratic Party President Oli Ahmed challenging the legality of an Anti-Corruption Commission notice asking for his wealth statement, saying that it was not moved properly. The ACC gave Oli a total of 14 days to submit his wealth statement after issuing the notice on September 8, said ACC's counsel Khurshid Alam Khan, adding that Oli, instead, filed the petition with the HC on September 14.

## Body found in Hatirjheel lake

Police recovered the body of an unidentified youth, aged around 25 years, from a lake of Hatirjheel yesterday afternoon. Locals first noticed the floating body clad in a T-shirt and jeans, near Hatirjheel Rainbow Crossing. Police found a packet containing marijuana from his pocket and sent the decomposed body to Dhaka Medical College morgue for an autopsy.

## ACC convictions falling

### Monthly press conference told

The conviction rate in Anti-Corruption Commission's (ACC) cases has on an average fallen since 2009 for, as a top official of the anti-graft watchdog seeking anonymity stated, lack of witnesses and proper evidence.

The yearly conviction rates in percentage starting from 2009 are 61, 56, 20, 32, 37 and 35 (in the eight months this year), state ACC papers.

Last month it was only 20, for the accused in only two of the 10 cases disposed of were convicted, ACC Secretary Maksudul Hassan Khan told its monthly press conference at its Segunbagicha office in the capital yesterday.

ACC last month decided to lodge 18 cases after receiving 865 allegations, he added.

A three-member body, comprising the ACC chairman and its two commissioners, decides on filing the cases. Moreover, the decision requires two votes, of which the chairman's is mandatory.

On why ACC, instead of doing so itself since it fell under its jurisdiction, just recommended the Ministry of Public Administration to sue five top government officials who resorted to forgery to obtain freedom fighters' certificates, Hassan stuck to his comment that it was an ACC decision.

The five are Health Secretary Niaz Uddin Mia, Public Service Commission Secretary AKM Amir Hossain, former liberation war affairs secretary KH Masud Siddiqui (now an officer on special duty or OSD), former liberation war affairs joint secretary Abul Kashem Talukder (now an OSD) and Privatisation Commission Chairman Molla Waheeduzzaman.

ACC investigation officer Zulfikar Ali, also a deputy director, submitted his investigation report to ACC on September 3 recommending that the authorities revoke the certificates and take legal and departmental action against them.

be his wife and mother-in-law, said police. Police yesterday filed a murder case against four people--Sanjida Akter Mishu, 20, the judge's self-proclaimed wife, her mother Lucky Akter, 40, her brother Imran Ahmed, 18, and their domestic help Rima, 18. Ten others were accused as unidentified, said police.

The four were arrested on Tuesday evening because Sanjida could not show the marriage documents. They said Hasib committed suicide after a quarrel with Sanjida.

Hasib had a hole in the middle of his skull and a black mark around his neck, said police, but the real cause of his death was not known immediately. Police said the post-mortem report would be available in a few days.

Meanwhile, a maternal uncle of the judge, Kazi Md Hamid, received the body from police and took it to the victim's house in Harirampur upazila of Manikganj, said Officer-in-Charge of Halishahar Police Station Shahjahan Kabir.

He said the judge lived with his wife, a daughter, and a son at his workstation in Naogaon. Why he went to Chittagong will be clarified once the arrestees are quizzed, he told The Daily Star by phone.

## Rural women spend 7hrs doing unpaid work, men only 1hr

### Says study

Women living in rural areas of the country spend, on average, seven hours a day doing unpaid work like cooking, while men only spend about one hour for this purpose, according to a non-government study. ActionAid Bangladesh, and Centre for Gender and Social Transformation (CGST) of Brac University disclosed findings of the study in a programme at Jatiya Press Club yesterday. The organisations conducted the study titled "Pattern of Time Use of Adult Women and Men in Rural North Bangladesh" between November 2013 and February 2014. A total of 345 persons (224 female and 121 male) of Lalmonirhat and Gaibandha were interviewed. Around 80 percent of the respondents believe that both the husband and the wife should earn for their families, while 50 percent of them feel that a man's work and a woman's work are equally important. While women's health risks increase in child marriage, it also comes between their education and independence, added the statement. The statement stressed that the Child Act 2013 defines children as anyone below 18 years of age. Besides, the Majority Act 1875 recognises anyone below 18 years of age as a minor.
