35th BCS exam's circular published

The Public Service Commission (PSC) yesterday published the circular of 35th Bangladesh Civil Service to fill 1,803 vacant posts of different cadres.

According to the circular uploaded on PSC's website, 455 will be recruited in general cadres, 484 in professional/technical cadres, 829 under education cadre (general colleges) and 35 under general education cadre (teacher training colleges). The applicants will have to apply online between 10:00am September 30 and 6:00pm October 30.

Journo dies at DMCH after falling ill

A local journalist of Desh TV died at Dhaka Medical College Hospital yesterday after he had fallen sick in a city hotel.

Moniruzzaman Monir, 45, a Jhalakathi correspondent of the private television, came to DMCH Saturday for treatment, the TV sources said. From the hotel in Bangshal where he checked in, Monir was taken to DMCH following a sudden illness around 12:30am yesterday. Police said an autopsy would be conducted today.

3 jailed for cheating people in name of giving jobs

A mobile court yesterday jailed three staff of an unauthorised job outsourcing firm in the capital's Bijoynagar for cheating people in the name of giving jobs.

Managing Director Meraj Hossain Tushar, 27, General Manager Sahidul Alam, 28, and Director Subarna Akter, 21, of "Gold Star Group" located on the eighth floor of Skylands Point were jailed for one year and fined Tk 2 lakh each.

They used to publish advertisements in newspapers and take handsome amount of money from job seekers, but in return they did not give the victims any job, said Executive Magistrate Anwar Pasha, who led the drive of Rapid Action Battalion. He said the frauds used to repeatedly shift their office to different locations in the capital to avoid arrest.

Convict Subarna, herself was also earlier cheated in a similar way, said the magistrate.

After the end of the seminar, we will review our own existing laws and policies to protect the rights of the victims of different forms of violence," she added.

Lawmaker Tarana Halim opined proposing reduction of the violence as one of the post-2015 millennium development goals.

Saleha Mehrzad of Afghanistan said their government was now taking different steps to encourage parents to send their children to schools and take health services.

and a half kilometres away from Majhukhan bazar and hacked its rider Bachchu Mia and his son, gold trader Sumon, and took away their belongings. They were admitted to a clinic in Dhaka.

Later, the robbers took away 20 tolas of gold ornaments, Tk 30,000 and four mobile phones and other valuables from the houses of Afzal Khan and Majid Mollah in the area after stabbing five members of the families.

Police arrested one Rasel Mia and Raju Mia in connection with the robbery incidents.

Ershad to blame

Chairman Ershad is currently a special envoy to Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina.

"He (Ershad) had started the process of making the entire army devoid of freedom fighters," alleged former major Manzur Ahmed.

Manzur Ahmed had been sacked after being accused of being one of the planners of the alleged coup which led to the assassination of President Ziaur Rahman on May 30, 1981.

Asked about Ershad's role during the Liberation War, Liberation War Affairs Minister AKM Mozammel Haque said, "He was in West Pakistan then and chaired the court which was formed to try the army officers who were pro-liberation."

Former army chief KM Shafiullah regretted Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman's decision to absorb repatriated officers from West Pakistan into the army after the Liberation War.

Shafiullah had headed a parliamentary standing committee in 2001 which termed the 1981 trial unfair and unjust and recommended that it be declared null and void.

Naim Jahangir demanded Ershad's trial for the killing of Zia and Major General Abul Manzur.

Naim was the only civilian jailed after being accused of being one of the planners of the 1981 coup. He was the then general secretary of freedom fighters' platform Muktiyoddha Sangsad.

"Ershad (the then army chief) wanted to change the post-mortem report of Maj Gen Mohammad Abul Manzur," he said, implying to Ershad's involvement in killing Manzur on the night of June 1, 1981 hours after his surrender following Zia's assassination. The families and victims demanded that they be provided pension and other financial benefits as recommended by the 2001 parliamentary committee and the real culprits behind the systematic killing be brought to justice.
