35 rescued from traffickers

Members of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) yesterday rescued 35 people, including 12 women, six children and 17 men while they were being trafficked to India through Putkhali Border under Benapole Port Police Station. Farid Uddin, Putkhali camp in-charge of BGB-23 Battalion, on secret information, a team raided the border area and rescued the victims. However, the traffickers managed to flee, sensing the presence of the border guards, he said. The victims hailed from Narail and Faridpur districts, said Farid, adding that they were later handed over to the police station. A case was filed in connection with the incident, he said.

11 idols vandalised

Criminals vandalised 11 idols of Hindu goddesses and gods at five temples in Batrish area of the district town on Wednesday night ahead of the Durga Puja, the largest religious festival of the country's Hindu community. A gang damaged heads and hands of four of goddess Durga, two of god Ganesh, two of god Kartik and other three idols of different temples at mid-night, said locals. Bijoy Krisna Roy, president of Kishoreganj Puja Udiapon Parishad, demanded immediate arrest and exemplary punishment to the culprits. SP Md Anwar Hossain Khan, Deputy Commissioner SM Alam and UNO Subroto Kumer Paul visited the spot.

16 houses gutted

At least 16 houses were gutted in a fire at Guchhagram in Khansama upazila yesterday afternoon. Witnesses said the fire originated at the kitchen of one Md Delwar Hossain and soon engulfed the adjoining houses. On information, firefighters rushed to the spot and doused the blaze with the help of locals. The affected house owners claimed that the loss caused by the fire could go up to Tk 12.7 lakh.

Son kills father

A man was killed allegedly by his son following a family feud at Dharmadah village in Daulatpur upazila yesterday. The dead is Lyakat Ali, 50, of the village. Enamul Haq, officer in-charge of Daulatpur police station, said Lyakat's son Ekhlash, 25, hit him with a sharp weapon in the head, leaving him critically injured. He was rushed to Kushtia Medical College and Hospital where he died in the afternoon. Ekhlash went into hiding after the incident, said the OC.

Fake dentist jailed

A mobile court here on Wednesday sentenced a fake dentist to six months' imprisonment. The court, led by executive magistrate Md Mijanur Rahman, raided Shapla intersection area in the town at 12:30pm and arrested Ershadul Islam, 48, in his chamber named 'Dantoghar'. At that time, Ershadul could not show any legal papers to the mobile court in support of giving medical treatment. He had been giving treatment for long in the area as a dentist, said the court sources.

Illegal ice cream factory fined

A mobile court fined an illegal ice cream factory at Ranipur village in Sadar upazila on Tuesday. The court, led by executive magistrate HM Salahuddin Manju, fined Rony ice cream factory Tk 40,000 for not having license from Bangladesh Standards and Testing Institution (BSTI). It also destroyed sub-standard ice cream of the factory worth Tk 50,000. In Kawkhali upazila town, executive magistrate Sheikh Rasheduzzaman fined two cloth shops Tk 2,000 in the evening for not having trade license.

GROSS IRREGULARITIES FOUND

Probe body suggests action against Domar sub-registrar

An investigation committee formed by the land directorate has found evidence of gross irregularities done by the sub registrar (land) of Domar upazila under the district.

The committee headed by district Registrar Khalilur Rahman submitted report to higher authority on September 15 for further action.

The committee detected that Domar sub registrar Abdul Halim Prodhان in collaboration with a section of dishonest officials of the office made a fake land purchase deed (No 668) on March 18 this year, taking signature and thumb impression of a fake owner to deprive the real owner, said sources in Nilphamari district land registrar's office.

The accused sub registrar made a number of such fake deeds in Domar land regis-

tration office to earn money illegally, the committee noticed.

In violation of rules, the sub registrar performed a number of purchasing deeds of property or plots although those are under legal procedure with civil court, found the investigation.

The inquiry committee further observed that in a particular deed, the seller sold only 8 decimals of land but it was falsely shown as 78 decimals in exchange of bribe.

The accused sub registrar usually remained absent in the office on Tuesday and Thursday when a deed writer who is not a government official received the deeds and kept them waiting for finalising after the sub-registrar's arrival, the probe body observed.

Different national and local newspapers ran reports on the irregularities, prompting the authorities



Two AL men hurt in bomb attack

Two local Awami League (AL) leaders were critically injured as a gang of masked criminal hurled two bombs at them at Jagannathpur village in Damurhuda upazila of Chuadanga on Wednesday night.

The injured are Aser Halsana, 35, general secretary of Jagannathpur ward unit of AL, and Yash Nabi, 32, joint secretary of the same unit. Both of them hail from Jagannathpur village.

Police quoted witnesses as saying that Aser and Nabi were gossiping with 8/10 fellow party activists at the office of a local journalist around

8:30pm. All of a sudden, a gang of masked criminals reached the spot and asked all but Aser and Nabi to leave the spot.

The criminal hurled two bombs targeting Aser and Nabi, leaving them critically injured. Aser's right hand was blown away while Nabi received splinter injuries, police said.

Later, the gang left the spot, firing several blank shots. They were admitted to Damurhuda Upazila Health Complex and then shifted to Rajshahi Medical College Hospital as their condition deteriorated.

Kamruzzaman, officer in-charge (OC) of Damurhuda Police Station, said they have recovered some splinters from the spot and are conducting drives to arrest the attackers.

3 get life for killing girl after rape

A Meherpur court yesterday sentenced three youths to life term imprisonment for killing a 15-year-old girl after rape in January 3, 2007.

The lifers are Suruj Ali, 32, son of Javed Ali, Samshul Alam, 22, son of Azad Ali, and Abdul Jabbar, 35, son of Khokon Ali of Dariapur village in Mujibnagar upazila of the district.

District Additional and Sessions Judge's Court Judge TM Musa handed down the verdict in presence of the convicts.

According to the prosecution, the convicts picked up Mabia

Khatun, daughter of Ali Javed of the same village from her residence on the night of January 3, 2007, when none of her family members were present at home.

The gang took Mabia to a nearby field and raped her. Later, they strangled the girl and dumped the body a canal of the village.

The following day, deceased's father lodged a case with Mujibnagar Police Station accusing Suruj, Samshul and Azad in this connection.

After investigation, police submitted the charge sheet against the three on May 13, 2007.

GOBINDAGANJ-DINAJPUR HIGHWAY

Cracks, potholes make journey difficult

An eight-kilometer stretch of the much used Gobindaganj-Dinajpur highway in the district is in an awful condition for long as numerous cracks and potholes have developed on the road.

Dhaka-bound coaches, buses and heavily loaded trucks from Dinajpur ply the highway round-the-clock everyday amid risk of accidents, thanks to ignorance of the authorities.

During the flood in 2008, eight kilometers of the highway, stretching from Gobindaganj upazila to Shahebganj cane farm, got damaged by the surging

water.

Later, the Roads and Highways Department (RHD) occasionally repaired the damaged portion but big cracks and potholes developed on the road in the last two years as no project for major renovation work was taken, said locals.

According to RHD, the road was constructed in 1988 to ease road communication of Dinajpur and Thakurgaon districts with the capital. Earlier, Dhaka-bound vehicles had to move an additional 40 kilometers through Sayedpur and Rangpur and that was time consuming too.

On completion of the

regional highway between Dhaka and Dinajpur via Gaibandha, the people of Dinajpur district were relieved of traveling the additional 40 km way.

Vehicles and transports of Madhyapara hard rock and Baropukuria coal mines prefer the road for carrying stone and coal to Dhaka and Chittagong. Besides, heavily loaded Indian trucks carrying imported commodities use the road from Hili border.

Contacted, Gaibandha RHD executive engineer Mahbubul Alam Khan said as at least 14 km way from Gobindaganj of Gaibandha to Kata of Dinajpur is in a sorry state, a major renovation work will begin soon.
