

Champions Bayern Munich crushed Werder Bremen 6-0 in the Bundesliga on Saturday to protect their four-point lead at the top as last season's runners-up Borussia Dortmund continued their poor run with a 2-1 loss at Cologne. Fellow Champions League participants Bayer Leverkusen

spectacularly imploded, giving up a 3-0 halftime lead to draw 3-3 against troubled VfB Stuttgart. With winger Franck Ribery making his comeback as a

substitute on the hour, league leaders Bayern were in complete control with Philipp Lahm and Xabi Alonso giving them an early two-goal cushion.

With Werder unable to counter the Bavarian attacks, a 43rd-minute penalty from Thomas Mueller and Mario Goetze's shot two minutes later killed off the game before and Sadio Mane piled on the agony for the penalty spot seven minutes later after forced Belardi into a save. Friedrich's looping header then qualifying match against halftime. Lahm and Goetze got their second goals of the after-

noon in the second half to lift Bayern to 20 points, four ahead of second-placed Borussia Moenchengladbach, who eased past Hanover 96 3-0 with two goals from forward Max Kruse.

Three months on from their World Cup semifinal hiding by Germany, Brazil have recovered their poise, former coach Carlos Alberto Parreira said Friday.

Parreira served as technical assistant to 2002 Cup-winning coach Luiz Felipe Scolari as the fivetimes champions were humbled 7-1 on home soil by eventual winners Germany. He and Scolari stepped down afterwards and former

High-flying Southampton thrashed Sunderland 8-0 in the Premier League on Saturday as unbeaten leaders Chelsea remained five points clear at the top with a 2-1 win away to

Crystal Palace. Sergio Aguero scored all Manchester City's goals in a 4-1 defeat of 10-man Tottenham Hotspur as the champions remained second while Arsenal needed a stoppage-time equaliser to seal a 2-2 draw with Hull -- the team they beat in last season's FA Cup final. Everton climbed up the table with a 3-0 win at home to Aston Villa but struggling Burnley were left searching for their first league win of the season after a 3-1 loss at home to West Ham.

At St Mary's, Southampton were 3-0 up at half-time, the goal rush starting when Sunderland's Santiago Vergini put through his own net when he volleyed in an attempted clearance in the 12th minute.

Graziano Pelle made it 2-0 six minutes later and there was more misery for the more than 2,000 travelling Sunderland fans who had made the long journey down from the north-east to the south coast when Jack Cork turned in from close range.

The goals kept coming in the second half, Liam Bridcutt diverting Pelle's shot into his own net for a second own-goal of the match before Pelle, Dusan Tadic, Victor Wanyama Sunderland.

hoped to make his come-


back on Sunday when Liverpool travel to Queens Park Rangers in the Premier League. But, according to the Liverpool Echo, the former
