

## UK minister Lynne Featherstone in town

UK Parliamentary Under Secretary of State for International Development Lynne Featherstone arrived in Dhaka yesterday on a three-day visit to see the efforts to bring to an end to child marriage and prevent violence against women and girls in Bangladesh.

The UK minister will meet Speaker Dr Shirin Sharmin Chaudhury, Finance Minister AMA Muhith, Minister for Women and Children Affairs Meher Afroze Chumki and State Minister for Foreign Affairs Shahriar Alam, said a press release of the British High Commission.

She will visit a number of UK aid-funded projects that support women's economic empowerment and social development.

## SC launches its museum today

The Bangladesh Supreme Court Museum will be launched today with an aim to inform the people about the apex court's history.

Chief Justice Md Muzammel Hossain will inaugurate the museum at a one-storey building in the administrative area of the court at 4:30pm.

The museum will contain historical and valuable case documents, furniture including docks, chairs and tables, and wall clocks which were used by SC judges and staff long ago, said an official, adding that many other exhibits will be added in future.

## SC asks Huji leader Sayeed to surrender at trial court

The Supreme Court yesterday directed Harkat-ul-Jihad-al Islami (Huji), Bangladesh leader Maulana Abu Sayeed to surrender before the trial court in two weeks in a bomb blast case in Sylhet.

The bomb blast took place in Sylhet's Fazil Chist area hours before a pre-poll rally of Awami League President Sheikh Hasina at Alia Madrasa ground at night on September 26, 2001. Two people were killed while making bombs. Fazil Chist area is 2km off the ground.

Sayeed was freed from jail after the High Court granted him bail on July 8 this year.

Yesterday, the SC cancelled the HC order of bail to Sayeed and ordered him to surrender before the trial court in Sylhet after hearing an appeal filed by the government seeking cancellation of the HC order.

Two other accused--Huji leader Mufi Abdul Hannan, and Shakil Ahmed alias Sumon--are now in jail.

## Road crashes kill four

Countrywide road accidents killed four people and injured 35 others yesterday and Saturday.

Our Munshiganj correspondent reports, two unidentified people were killed and four others injured when a bus rammed into a microbus on Dhaka-Chittagong highway in Tetuitala area of Gazaria upazila yesterday.

In Madhyan Farazi Kandi area, two people died and 25 people were injured when a bus fell into roadside ditch after its driver lost control over the vehicle on the highway.

The deceased were Masud Rana, 18, and Khadem Ali, 23.

Our Moulvibazar correspondent reports, Harunur Rashid, 43 of Shibpasa village died and four people were injured when a lorry collided head-on with a CNG-run auto-rickshaw in Bahubol area of Habiganj on Saturday.

A correspondent from Chittagong adds Md Abdullah, 20, of Pashchim Hinguli died and two people were injured when a covered-van hit a CNG-run auto-rickshaw, carrying them, from behind on Dhaka-Chittagong highway in Dhumghat area of Mirsarai upazila yesterday.

CONTEMPT RULE

A junior defence counsel Gazi HM Tamim yesterday prayed for a date for the hearing of a petition he submitted yesterday on behalf of the Sangram editor, reporter and Ekramul, former Badarganj Muktiyoddha Sangsad unit commander, offering an all-out and unconditional apology.

The tribunal issued the rule on August 3 when the sole defence witness in the war crimes case against Jamaat leader ATM Azharul Islam showed two news reports

published at Sangram on December 27, 2013 and January 26, 2014.

The reports, "Allegations brought against Azhar during the Liberation War are baseless" and "There was no student leader named Azhar from [19]69 to [19]74", were published quoting Ekramul and Azizur.

Azizur, a lawyer and Bangladesh Chhatra League's Rangpur district unit president of 1971, in another petition yesterday, stated that he did not say anything mentioned in that report. He, however, sought forgiveness from the tribunal.

Teknaf and a special economic zone in Chittagong, said the foreign secretary.

Hasina said an ample scope had been created in the Bay of Bengal following settlement of disputes with India and Myanmar on Bangladesh's sovereignty over a vast maritime area.

In response to Hasina's request, the DP World said they usually set up a special economic zone near any sea port to make it viable and would send a delegation to Bangladesh soon for the next course of action.

Hasina welcomed the idea of constructing a special economic zone near the deep-sea port and urged the DP World to conduct another feasibility study on constructing a big airport on reclaimed land in Bangladesh.

The DP World has a portfolio of over 65 marine terminals across six continents.

Jatiyatabadi Sramik Dal president of ward No. 46, but the court did not allow it as he fell sick inside the courtroom during the trial procedure.

The court also sent the other 56 to jail after they had been produced before it without any remand prayer for them.


Defence sought cancellation of the remand prayer and appealed to the court to grant them bail.

This was the second highest mass apprehension of BNP activists from a single spot since March 11 last year when police had arrested over 164 BNP men after raiding the party headquarters in Naya Paltan.

## Punishment for Rangpur Medical College Hospital interns, staff demanded

Local journalists yesterday demanded punishment for the interns and staff of Rangpur Medical College Hospital who confined three journalists and damaged a video camera on Saturday.

At a meeting in Ekattor TV office in the city's Jummapara, they also demanded compensation giving a 24-hour ultimatum to the hospital authorities.

Presided over by local daily Dabanal Editor Golam Mostafa Batul, the meeting was addressed, among others, by The Independent correspondent Abdus Shahed Montu.

On Saturday morning, the interns and staff of the paediatrics department at the hospital confined three journalists of two private TV channels to the department for half an hour as they were shooting footage for a special story on the department.

The confined were Shah Bayejid Ahmed, Rangpur district correspondent of EkattorTV; Shaheen Alam, its videographer; and Moudud Ahmed Dalim, Rtv videographer.
