Woman set on fire by husband

A woman who was set on fire allegedly by her husband on Sunday is fighting for her life at Dhaka Medical College Hospital. The victim is Runa Aktar, 20, daughter of Dulal Miah

and wife of Hazrat Ali, who works as a mason. The couple lives in Bir Uzoli village under Kapasia upazila of Gazipur. According to locals, Hazrat and Runa often quarrelled

due to dowry related matters. On Sunday, Hazrat told Runa to bring him Tk 10,000 from her father, but she refused leading to another argument. At one stage, an angry Hazrat poured kerosene on Runa and set her on fire.

Liberia and Nigeria.

It will take a few more months, which is "longer than normal" to contain the outbreak in West Africa, he said.

The expert cited a weak health system, shortages of health equipment, events of health workers denying treatment to Ebola patients and certain social norms as contributors to the rapid rise in the numbers of cases and deaths there.

However, Dr Rajesh said, the risk of Ebola is very low in the WHO South-East Asia region--Bangladesh, Bhutan, North Korea, India, Indonesia, the Maldives, Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Thailand and East Timor.

"These countries have comparatively better health systems and have had time to prepare themselves."

He said the countries had ports of entry screening mechanisms for the people travelling from or routing through West African, and had got designated places to isolate Ebola suspects and a system through the WHO to diagnose a suspected case very quickly. "The only thing we should do if a case comes is respond

to it effectively. Two countries--Senegal and Nigeria--have done it. So these countries are Ebola-free," he said.

Dr Rajesh emphasised that misinformation, fear and stigma might have a damaging impact on a country. The production and supply chains may collapse, leading to food shortages and an economic downturn, he said.

According to him, public awareness and governments preparedness on Ebola are more important than vaccines or drugs that may not come to the market in next two to three months.

"Developing a new medicine needs time. It needs to be researched and experimented. The WHO is working with many pharmaceutical companies to shorten this time so that people get this product sooner and people get a safe and quality product," said Dr Rajesh.

He thinks the absence of medicine is not a threat, but drugs will surely complement the governments' efforts to prevent the disease, which has more than a 50 percent fatality rate.
