# Woman takes her life after killing son

A woman killed her eight-month-old son and later committed suicide at Sayodtula village in Sarail upazila yesterday. The deceased are Bina Akhter, 27, wife of Milon Mia of Kuttapara village in the upazila and her son Shamim.

Police and locals said Bina often engaged in altercation with the family members of her husband over family matter.

As a sequel to the family feud, Bina along with her two children --- Shamim and Samia-- went to her father's house a few days ago.

Yesterday afternoon, Bina killed Shamim and injured

her daughter. Later, she took her life by hanging herself from the ceiling of her room.

Police suspected that Shamim was strangled.

The bodies were sent to Brahmanbaria Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy, said Md Ali Arshad, officer in-charge of Sarail Police Station.

### Woman drowns in pond

UNB, Sirajganj

A housewife drowned in a pond at Dhukuria Bera village in Belkuchi upazila on Wednesday noon. The deceased was identified as Bilkis Khatun, 23, wife of Abul Baki, of Kalagachi village. Locals said Bilkis drowned in the pond adjacent to her house while washing clothes. Later, locals recovered her floating body after a frantic search.

### 3 Jamaat-Shibir men held

Police arrested three Jamaat-Shibir men in Uttarbaraz area of Kulaura upazila headquarters yesterday afternoon. The arrestees are Md Abdur Barik, 60, upazila Jamaat ameer and Shibir activists Mujahidul Islam, 19, Jamal Uddin, 27 of the area. They were arrested when they started picketing in the area during hartal sponsored by Jamaat, said Amol Kumar Dhar, officer in-charge of Kulaura Police Station.

### Rice mill worker electrocuted

A rice mill worker was electrocuted at Hatgopalpur Bazar under Sadar upazila on Wednesday morning. The dead is Billal Hossain, 32, son of Anwar Hossain of Teurdah Koloni para in the upazila. Bikas Biswas, chairman of Jhenidah Sadar Upazila Parishad, said Billal came in contact with a live electric wire while working at the mills owned by Kajal Hossain. He died at Sadar hospital around 11:00am.

### Man killed in clash

A man was killed and 30 others were injured in a clash between two rival groups in Sadar upazila of Sunamganj district on Tuesday. The deceased is Tofazzal Hossain, 45, son of Abdul Jabbar of Paikapan village. Police said an altercation took place between two groups of Paikapan and Asampur villages over fishing in a haor (water body) at Jamtala in the afternoon. At one stage, the rival groups, equipped with lethal weapons and firearms, attacked each other, leaving 31 people injured. Of them, critically injured Tofazzal was rushed to Sylhet Osmani Medical College Hospital where he died at 10:00 pm. A case was filed in this connection, said Al-Amin, officer in-charge of Sadar Police Station.

### JCD leader arrested

Police in a drive arrested a local leader of Bangladesh Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) from Barkapon area in the town on Wednesday. The detainee, Alim Hossain Miru, son of a late Mofiz Mia, of Tailakbijoy village in Sadar upazila, is the senior joint-convenor of district unit of JCD. Contacted, Nazma Begum, sub-inspector of Sadar Model Police Station, said being informed, police nabbed Miru, accused in a case filed with the police station.

### Prisoner dies in Panchagarh

A prisoner died at Panchagarh Sadar Hospital on Wednesday. The deceased is Wazed Ali, 60, of Alamnagar village in Debiganj upazila of Panchagarh. Yunus Zaman, jailer of Panchagarh District Jail, said on Monday evening, Wazed was arrested in a rape case and sent to district jail. Yesterday morning he complained about a chest pain and was rushed to the hospital where he died around 8:45am. An unnatural death (UD) case was filed with Panchagarh Sadar Police Station.

### Man to die for killing wife for dowry

A Bogra court yesterday sentenced a man to death for killing his wife in 1997.

The convict is Reaz Uddin, 56, son of late Essha Fakir of Bagarpara area in Sadar upazila, reports our correspondent.

According to the prosecution, Reaz along with his five accomplices murdered his wife Peyara Khatun, daughter of late Mohir Uddin Fakir of the same area, for dowry on April 19, 1997.

Victim's brother filed a murder case with Sadar Police Station against six people including Reaz.

On August 19 the same year, Sub-inspector Humam Kabir submitted a charged sheet to the Women and Children Repression Prevention Tribunal-1 against the six after investigation.

After examining witnesses and evidence, Judge SM Saiful Islam handed down the verdict, acquitting five other accused as their involvement in the killing could not be proved.

Away in Habiganj, a housewife was hacked to death allegedly by her husband at Ikram village in Baniarchang upazila on Wednesday night.

The dead is Aheda Khatun, 30, wife of Nasir Mia of the village and daughter of Abdur Rashid of the area, reports our Moulvibazar correspondent.

Quoting locals police said said Nasir engaged in an altercation with his wife over a family matter on the night. At one stage, he hit Aheda with a sharp weapon, leaving her dead on the spot.

## SADULLAPUR UPAZILA IN GAIBANDHA

# Bridge collapse snaps road links

Vehicular movement on Sadullapur-Dhaperhat Road in Sadullapur upazila has remained stopped for over two months due to collapse of an old bridge.

Despite repeated appeals by locals, the authorities concerned did not take any initiative to repair the bridge. Recently, they (villagers) constructed a mud road adjacent to the bridge only for the movement of richshaws.

A large portion of the old bridge collapsed in the last week of August under the pressure of a goods-laden vehicle, suspending movement of buses and trucks.

Locals said they repeatedly urged the authorities to build a new bridge, replacing the old one, but to no effect.

"Following collapse of the bridge, we requested the officials of LGED to take immediate steps to repair the bridge, but they are yet to take any step to do the

job," Shahidul Islam Shipon, chairman of Dhaperhat Union Parishad, said.

Only a few days ago, the people of the union joined hands and built a mud road beside the bridge for the movement of pedestrians and richshaws, the chairman added.

Contacted, Upazila LGED Engineer Azizu Huq said they have already sent a proposal to the higher authority for reconstruction of the bridge.
