

US immigration visas can be collected in Sylhet, Ctg

Bangladeshis can now collect immigration visas for the United States and submit post-interview documents in Sylhet and Chittagong, besides the capital.

Previously, immigration visa applicants had to visit the office of the US embassy in the capital for document submission and visa collection, but now, they will be able to complete the process at Visa Collection Centres in the three cities.

Besides, a new website, www.ustraveldocs.com/bd, has been launched to make the process easier.

This information was unveiled at the inaugural ceremony of US Visa Collection Centre at Saimon Centre in the capital yesterday.

US Ambassador in Dhaka Dan Mozena was the chief guest at the programme.

adults with less than 10 and 20 percent burns respectively are advised to be treated as outpatients.

The hospital has the best burn management unit in the country but it still lacks amenities to treat patients with more than 50 percent burns, inhalation injuries, and electrical burns.

It now needs a modern wound-dressing chamber, sufficient respiratory supports for inhalation injuries, hyperbaric oxygen therapy, especially for the electrical burn patients, said a doctor.

"Most patients died of infection either because their wounds were dressed casually or they were treated in an unhygienic environment on the floor. Around 50 percent of infections can be checked by using the modern dressing chamber," said a doctor at the unit, preferring to remain unnamed.

The hospital has arrangements for only five respiratory supports in the ICU but it receives 10 to 12 patients with inhalation injuries daily in winter and four to five in other times, he said. "Because of the shortage, patients are given respiratory support only when their condition is the worst."

Dr Tanveer Ahmed said the physicians had no choice but to chop off limbs affected by electrical burns due to a lack of hyperbaric oxygen therapy.

On the back of such shortages, Atiur Rahman, Bangladesh Bank's governor, urged all banks and financial institutions to assist the burn unit by providing modern tools and help increase its capacity.

DMCH Director Brig Gen Mustafizur Rahman, Adviser of National Institute of Burn and Plastic Surgery Dr Samanta Lal Sen, and the institute's Director Prof Abul Kalam, among others, also spoke.

that Jabbar held a meeting at his father-in-law's house with Razakars and decided to attack influential Hindu families of Angulkata and Mathbaria villages.

"On that night at about 11:00pm we saw them going towards Angulkata village," he said, adding that he along with others followed them.

He stated of seeing them attacking the house of the Mitra family and looting valuables.

"After the looting, they tied 19 persons with their hands behind their backs and took them to Mathbaria. On the way, the Razakars also attacked Kirtonia Bari, Majhi Bari, Hawladar Bari, Bala Bari and Haldar Bari," Akon said, adding that 37 Hindus were detained in total.

After holding a discussion among themselves, they released seven and took the rest to Surjamoni Wapda Road, where they were lined up and shot by the Razakars, he said.

CPA introduces security uniform for staff, port users

Chittagong Port Authority (CPA) yesterday introduced colour-coded security uniforms for its workers, staff, and stakeholders who use the port's restricted area with an aim to ensure security as well as safety of all.

Shipping Minister Shajahan Khan inaugurated the uniform under the International Ship and Port Facility Security Code programme through a ceremony at 4 No Container Yard of the port.

The security waistcoats come in four colours—orange for workers and drivers, yellow for CPA and customs staff, blue for staff of the stakeholders or port users, and green for all cleaners.

Around 5,000 vehicles including trucks, vans, prim movers and around 15,000 people use the port every day, said CPA Chairman Rear Admiral Nizamuddin Ahmed.

The uniform in distinct colours would help maintain security and protection of people against avoidable accidents, he said.

CPA Director (Security) Lt Col Alamgir Kabir told The Daily Star that CPA yesterday distributed 1,000 waistcoats among the port staff while organisations using the port like berth operators and clearing and forwarding agents provided 4,000 waistcoats to their staff.

The rest will get the uniform gradually, he said.

Mahila Parishad demands arrest of Rangpur girl's rapist

Bangladesh Mahila Parishad yesterday demanded immediate arrest of the fugitive rapist of a Rangpur girl and security for her family members.

On Friday night, Ekramul Haque, 22, son of rice trader Delwar Rahman of a village in Pirganj upazila, allegedly raped the girl, who is also a JSC examinee, while she was home alone, says a report published in The Daily Star yesterday.
