

### BCL MEN, BCS EXAM Favouritism violation of constitution

BNP acting secretary general Mirza Fakhru Islam Alamgir and Jamaat-e-Islami central executive committee member Hamidur Rahman Azad yesterday criticised HT Imam, one of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's advisers, for his remarks on Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) men taking civil service examinations.

"We will see how much we can help you with the viva voce... Our leader has told us to arrange jobs for you by any means," Imam told a discussion at Dhaka University on Wednesday. Hasina however had said just the opposite at a meeting the day before.

Fakhru, at a Jatiyatabadi Svecchhasebak Dal discussion in the capital's Institution of Engineers, Bangladesh, and Hamidur, in a statement, said the privilege assurance violated the constitution, which says there should be no discrimination in public service recruitment.

Hamidur urged for waging a movement, accusing the government of depriving general students

### DEMANDING BUSINESS CONTRACT IN CTG BCL leader ransacks shipping agent's office

Central committee suspends him

The central committee of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) suspended Zakaria Dastagir, joint secretary of Chittagong city unit of BCL, last evening after he allegedly led an attack on a local shipping agent's office in Chittagong city earlier in the day.

Sheikh Russel, office secretary of the BCL central body, confirmed the news to The Daily Star.

Zakaria, with over 100 of his followers, ransacked the office of Globe Shipping Lines Ltd around 12:30pm, demanding that the firm sign a contract with him for collection of waste oil from ships, said witnesses and police.

Police said Naoshad Pintu, another BCL activist, was currently doing the work but Zakaria wanted the firm to appoint him.

Meanwhile, on information, some 50 followers of Pintu rushed to the spot but police dispersed both groups, said Jahedul Islam, officer-in-charge of Bandar Police Station.

The officials of Globe Shipping Lines were not available to comment.

### KNIFE ATTACK ON RU BCL LEADER Accused leading protests!

A Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) vice president, recently suspended from Rajshahi University (RU), led a procession yesterday protesting Wednesday's knife attack on a deputy office secretary who is accusing him of masterminding the assault.

Undergoing treatment at Rajshahi Medical College Hospital, Abdullah Al Mamun alias Shimul was stabbed five times in the right leg by some unidentified attackers at the Zuberi playground on the campus.

Refuting the allegation, President Mizanur Rahman and General Secretary Khalid Hasan, who had also led the procession demanding immediate arrest of the attackers, said Tanmoy Ananda Avi was still in BCL for he had not been expelled.

Tanmoy was suspended after he and

### CU BCL Illegal money-making source of infighting

Says AL leader Mohiuddin Chy; sits with two factions tomorrow

Senior Awami League leader ABM Mohiuddin Chowdhury yesterday said the reason of the debilitating infighting in Bangladesh Chhatra League at Chittagong University was centred about getting the share of illegal money on the campus.

"I wouldn't say any particular faction is good," he said. The Chittagong city AL president made the remarks while talking to The Daily Star over Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's directives on Chittagong AL leaders to resolve the BCL conflict.

Mohiuddin said they would hold a meeting tomorrow in this regard with the university authorities, police, and the warring factions of the AL's unofficial student body to find an amicable solution for the two groups' peaceful coexistence on the campus. Hasina, also AL's president, gave the directives on Wednesday, he said.

### SC stays HC bail to 'ISIS recruit' till Nov 16

Following a government appeal, the Supreme Court yesterday stayed till November 16 the November 10 High Court bail granted to Asif Adnan Shuvo, allegedly recruited as an ISIS fighter by a UK citizen of Bangladeshi origin, in a case filed under Anti-terrorism Act 2009 for "conspiring to commit terrorist and militant activities".

The four-member bench headed by Chief Justice Md Muzammel Hossain will further hear the appeal on November 16.

Now in Dhaka Central Jail, former HC Judge Abdus Salam Mamun's 26-year-old son was arrested at his Segunbagicha residence in the capital on September 24. That day a senior bureaucrat's son, Fazle Elahi Tanzil, 24, was also arrested at the government quarters at Eskaton.

Alleged supporters of emerging radical militant outfit Ansarullah Bangla Team, the duo were reportedly planning to go to Syria through Turkey with the UK citizen's help posing as members of Tabligh Jamaat, a

## Thought for food



### Adulteration and contamination of poultry products

Poultry meat and eggs are rich in protein and highly nutritious. They are good sources of phosphorus, minerals and vitamin, especially B-complex. Chicken and turkey are the common sources of poultry meat and other sources are ducks, geese, and pigeons etc. Poultry meat contains less fat than red meat and healthier for human consumption. However, worldwide poultry meat is adulterated and contaminated in many ways from primary production to consumption. Adulteration means adding any substance or element to natural food or adding during preparation or removing any element from the food.

### Poultry meat adulteration and physical contamination:

Whole chicken or chicken portion (breast, thigh) is injected with water or soaking into water to add extra weight. Feathers and other foreign body (nuts, bolts, piece of paper) may be present due to lack of good manufacturing practices. Poultry meat may be contaminated chemically or microbiologically with dirty water and may be injurious due to presence of foreign body.

**Prevention:**

- Strong monitoring by the enforcement authority
- Establish modern slaughtering and poultry processing industries with the help of Govt. and foreign aid
- Wise not to buy too soggy raw dressed chicken
- Water content shouldn't be more than 10%

### Chemical Contamination in poultry meat and eggs:

Chemical contamination in poultry may pose a huge threat to public health due to use of over doses of antibiotics and hormones as well as cleaning chemicals. Unhealthy feeds are produced by using chemical (chromium) contaminated tannery waste and chemical residue transferring through poultry products to the human body. Research has been conducted by various Organizations (BRAC, University of Dhaka) in Bangladesh and outcome is not satisfactory. Contamination may lead to long run health effects such as cancer, ulcer, liver cirrhosis and kidney damages or failure.

**Prevention:**

- Adopt HACCP (Hazards Analysis Critical Control point) based Food Safety Management System which ensures product safety throughout the process and legislative requirement for manufacturing feeds for poultry, fish and cattle
- Good Veterinary practices
- Strong monitoring on tannery waste recycling procedure

### Microbiological contamination:

Live poultry may become infected with avian influenza (known as bird's flu) viruses (both HPAI 5 & HPAI 7 and LPAI viruses) through direct contact with infected waterfowl or other infected poultry, or contact with surfaces that have been contaminated with the viruses. Viruses can be spread rapidly through contaminated flocks of poultry. Common signs- depression, appetite, folded feathers and fever. Hens may lay soft-shelled eggs. Other common diseases are newcastle, salmonellosis fowl cholera, chronic respiratory disease, coccidiosis. Poultry meat also contaminates with spoilage and pathogenic bacteria. Raw poultry meat may carry bacteria or introduce bacteria during handling, transportation, storing or may survive due to lack of thorough cooking. salmonella spp, Campylobacter jejuni, Escherichia coli (E. coli) are commonly associated bacteria with raw poultry.

**Prevention:**

- Adopt HACCP (Hazards Analysis Critical Control point) based Food Safety Management System which ensures product safety throughout the process
- Establish modern slaughtering and poultry processing industries
- Good Veterinary practices & GMP
- Food retail should buy according to the spec. Recommend to establish own farm and processing plant.
- Store raw poultry at or below 5°C in the refrigerator or chiller
- Store raw poultry minimum -18°C in the freezer
- Cook thoroughly. Most of the bacteria die at 72-75°C. boiling temperature is recommended
- Check core temperature after cooking
- Hold cooked poultry products at or above 63°C.
- Reheat chilled products at 75°C
- Don't use expire poultry products

## Nasim for TIB report with specific evidence

Health Minister Mohammad Nasim yesterday asked the Transparency International Bangladesh to present its report on health sector corruptions with specific evidence.

"The health ministry is critically studying the TIB report on health sector governance, and will respond to it," he said at a press briefing at the ministry after a meeting on the cleanliness drive in public hospitals and improving service quality.

On November 6, TIB in the report said recruitment, transfer and promotion in public health sector involve bribes from Tk 10,000 to Tk 10 lakh in each case.

Ruling party people, officials at the Directorate General of Health Services and civil surgeon's office and trade union leaders are mostly engaged in the corruptions, it said.

In reaction, Nasim said if TIB provided specific allegations with evidence, action would take be taken against those found corrupt.
