# Saline water floods aman fields in Kalapara

Over 100 acres of aman paddy land at Nizampur in Kalapara upazila under the district have been flooded with saline water that entered through the damaged part of a flood control embankment on the Ramnabad River under the influence of full moon during the last one week.

"I cultivated Aman paddy on five areas of land that total captured by saline water which entered through the damaged part of the flood control dam. We are very worried as salinity affected aman paddy is being mildewed," said Md Hafez Fakir, a farmer.

Solaiman Sharif, another farmer of the same area, said they were supposed to reap aman paddy after 15 to 20 days but they became frustrated as the fields got flooded with saline water.

"About 300 metres of the embankment collapsed into river in the rainy season. In September, we formed a human chain at Kalapara upazila parishad premises, urging the authorities to repair the embankment but in vain. Finally saline water entered the paddy fields through the damaged part of

the embankment," he said. The near ripe aman paddy would be saved if the authority repaired the 300 metres of the damaged

embankment, said Abdul Maleque Akon, chairman of local union parishad. Md Shafi Uddin Ahmed, executive engineer for

Patuakhali Water Development Board, said they could not repair the embankment in time due to lack of fund.

# Robbers kill college girl, injure two in B'baria

A college girl was killed and two others were injured in an attack by a gang of robbers during a robbery incident at Islamabad village in Sarail upazila of the district early yesterday.

The deceased, Ratna Akter, 19, daughter of Osman Mia of the village, was a first-year BBA (Hons) student at Islampur Degree College.

Police quoted deceased family members as saying that a gang of armed robbers entered the house by cutting grills of a window and kept the house members hostage at gunpoint.

Later, the gang looted gold ornaments, mobile phones sets and other valuables from the house.

The gang attacked Ratna and two of her family members when Ratna cried for help from another room of the house. They stabbed her in the head, chest and stomach and fled the scene along with the booties.

Ratna succumbed to her injuries on way to Dhaka Medical College Hospital while the injured, including her father Osman Mia, were undergoing treatment at Sarail Upazila Health Complex.

Being informed, police went to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to Brahmanbaria Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Contacted, Mohammad Abdul Haque, officer in-charge (investigation) of Sadar Police Station, said they have already arrested

four people for their alleged involvement in the robbery.

UNB adds: Robbers looted valuables from a house at Tirashi village in Dakkhin Surma upazila on early Friday.

Locals said a gang of robbers stormed into the house of Delwar Mia at the village at around 4:30am and tied up three family members.

They looted Tk3 lakh, three tolas of gold ornaments and three mobile phone sets from the house.

Two people, including Afsa Begum, 47, and Sumaiya, 15, were injured as they tried to resist the gang. Being informed, police rushed in and chased the robbers. They, however, managed to flee with the booties.

# Schoolboy electrocuted

A 15-year-old boy was electrocuted at Mosquepara village in Sadar upazila of the district on Friday night.

Deceased, Fahim Hasan, 15, son of Tutul Haque of the village, was a Class IX student at Chuadanga VJ Government High School.

Police quoting witnesses said Fahim and his friends used to play Badminton at a filed near his house every evening.

He came in contact with a live electric-wire while disconnecting the cable from the main line to switch-off the lights around 10:00pm.

Locals rushed him to Sadar Hospital where the doctors declared him dead, said Munshi Asaduzzaman, officer in-charge of Sadar Police Station.

An unnatural death (UD) case was lodged with the police station, added the OC.

# Auto-rickshaw driver found murdered

A 'missing' CNG-run three-wheeler driver was found murdered in Erendah area under Raiganj upazila of Sirajganj district yesterday.

The deceased is Md Jahangir Hossain, 30, son of Tazim Uddin of Chak-Monarpur village.

Jahangir went out of home with his vehicle on Friday morning and he went missing, said Md Rezaul Haque, officer in-charge of Raiganj Police Station.

Being informed, police recovered his body from beside Dhaka-Sirajganj highway in the area around 9:00am yesterday and sent it to Sirajganj General Hospital morgue for autopsy.

A gang of muggers might have strangled Jahangir and later took away his vehicle, said the OC.

# Woman held with Yaba

Police arrested a woman drug peddler along with 200 Yaba tablets in Chanchra Raipara area under Sadar upazila of Jessore district on Friday night.

The arrestee is Zobeda Begum, 35, wife of Zafar Sheikh of the area.

# Two housewives killed for 'dowry'

Two housewives were killed allegedly for dowry in Sadar and Gouripur upazilas on Friday.

The bodies were sent to Mymensingh Medical College and Hospital (MMCH) morgue for autopsy.

In Sadar upazila, Mazeda Begum, 32, wife of farmer Bachchu Miah of Patnipara village, was beaten up allegedly by her in-laws following a feud over dowry at night.

The incident took place when Bachchu Mia was not at home, said police.

Critically injured Mazeda died on way to MMCH, said Abu Md Fazlul Karim, officer in-charge of Kotwali Police Station.

In another incident, a six-

month-old pregnant woman was beaten to death allegedly by her husband for dowry at Amapara village under Gouripur upazila.

The dead is Nasreen Akhtar, 19, wife of Sohel Akhtar, a private job holder of the upazila, said police.

Nasreen married Sohel 10 months ago. After the marriage, Sohel and his parents used to torture her for dowry.

Following an altercation over the issue on Friday afternoon, Sohel and his family members hit Nasreen with heavy sticks, leaving her dead on the spot.

Police arrested Sohel and his mother, said OC Mohammad Ali Sheikh of Gouripur Police Station. The arrestees were yesterday produced before a court that sent them to jail, he added.

# BRTC bus catches fire, 5 injured

A passenger bus of the state-owned Bangladesh Road Transport Corporation (BRTC) caught fire due to a mechanical fault in Dharmadas area in the city of Friday.

At least five passengers received minor injuries while trying to get down from the bus hurriedly. They were given primary treatment at a local clinic.

Abdul Qader Jilani, offi-

cer in-charge of Kotwali Police Station, quoting witnesses said the CNG-run Panchagarh-bound bus from Bogra was carrying at least 50 passengers.

It caught fire around 5:00pm.

The fire originated from the engine of the bus due to a mechanical fault, the OC added.

Being informed, two fire fighting units from Rangpur Fire Service and Civil Defence Station rushed to the spot and doused the fire.

# Boy burnt alive, 5 makeshift hotels gutted in fire

A teenage boy was burnt alive and five roadside makeshift hotels were gutted in a fire in housingmore area of the town yesterday.

The deceased, Md Aynul Haque, 16, son of Abdul Khaleque of Nishchintapur village in Sadar upazila, was an employee of a hotel owned by one Md Sultan Ali.

Quoting locals, station officer of Dinajpur Fire Service AKM Morshed said the fire originated at the kitchen of Sultan's hotel at around 5:30am

and soon engulfed the adjoining makeshift hotels.

Being informed, fire fighters rushed to the spot and extinguished the fire around 7:00am. They later recovered the Aynul' charred body.

Md Altaf Hossain, officer in-charge of Dinajpur Sadar Police Station, said some local influential men built the makeshift hotels in the area beside Dinajpur-Dhaka highway since the Islami Bank Hospital started its functioning five years ago.

## Kid drowns

Family sources said he went missing on Friday morning when he went to take bath in the river. Later, fire service divers from Chittagong recovered his body from Sangu yesterday morning.

## Indian clothes seized

Members of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) seized Indian sarees, three pieces and medicines worth Tk 32.5 lakh from Amrakhali area of the district on Friday. Major Liaquat Hossain, deputy commander of 26 BGB Battalion, said on secret information, the border guards raided the area in the morning and seized the smuggled goods. However none was arrested in this connection, he said. A case was filed.

## Boy falls from tree, dies

A nine-year-old schoolboy died after falling from a tree at Gaidghat village in Sadar upazila on Friday afternoon. The deceased was identified as Niob Hossain, son of Jalal Uddin of the village and a class two student at Gaidghat Government Primary School. Locals and Police said Niob climbed a jackfruit tree for collecting leaves but accidentally fell to ground after breaking one of its branches. He died on way to Rajshahi Medical College and Hospital.

## 4 maunds of jatka seized

Detectives in a drive seized four maunds of jatka (hilsa fry) at toll plaza in Patuakhali Bridge area on Friday night. Police said a gang of fish traders was loading the jatka in Meghna paribahan, a passenger bus on Kuakatat- Dhaka road. On information, DB police seized the hilsa fry kept in two cartons from the rooftop of the bus. Later, the fishes distributed among poor people and six local orphanages in the town in presence of Executive Magistrate Md Alamgir Hossain.

## 3 arrested with phensidyl

Detective Branch (DB) of police arrested three drug peddlers along with 147 bottles of phensidyl at Sitarampur Bhangra Bridge in Sadar upazila on Friday. The arrestees are Rony Islam, 30, son of Amirul Islam, a resident of Shaigharia village in Sadar upazila, Alam Khan, 32, son of late Ayon Uddin of Srikantapur village in Atgharia upazila, and Joyal Hossain, 42, son of late Jafar Ali of Krishnapur village in Sadar upazila of Pabna. Acting on a tip-off, a team of DB police conducted a drive in the area and intercepted a microbus at around 8:00am. Later, police arrested the trio and seized the 147 bottles of phensidyl syrup from the vehicle. Rezaul Karim, officer-in-charge of Sadar Police Station, confirmed the incident.

# Trader rescued 10 hours into abduction

## Two kidnappers arrested in Benapole

A cattle trader was rescued ten hours after his abduction from Putkhali area under Benapole Port Police Station on Friday.

Police also arrested two abductors Sakkarul Ali, 30, son of Khorshed Ali of Goyra village, and Abdul Mannan, 32, son of

Nasiruddin Mia of Kagojpukur village under the police station.

Apurbo Hasan, officer in-charge (OC) of Benapole Port Police Station, two abductors picked up Sarwar from Putkhali cattle market at gunpoint around 11:00am.

Later, the gang members phoned the victim's family members and demanded Tk

5 lakh as ransom for his release.

Following a complaint lodged by Sarwar's family members with the police station, the law enforcers raided Putkhali area, tracking the abductors cellphone numbers and rescued Sarwar from there around 9:00pm, the OC added.

Police also arrested two kidnappers from the spot.
