Social and personal service providers contribute 10 percent of gross domestic product, according to a survey, the first of its kind.

Termed the Community Social and Personal Services (CSPS) providers, they accounted for Tk 41,342 crore of GDP in fiscal 2011-12, said the study commissioned by Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics.

The CSPS has three categories: the professional, scientific and technical

services; household services; and other service activities. The professional, scientific and technical services include firms in areas of law, chartered accountancy, engineering, research, management consulting, architecture, advertising and market research organisations.

Ctg to get biomass power plant soon

UNB, Kuala Lumpur

A biomass power plant will be set up in Chittagong soon to generate 10 megawatts of electricity with an initial investment of \$16 million.

Renewable Energy Sources Sdn Bhad of Malaysia and Well Trade of Bangladesh yesterday joined hands for the plant that will generate electricity from biomass by using municipal solid wastes.

Syed Nurul Islam, chief executive officer of Well Group Industries, and Victor Kuan Wai Teck signed a deal in this regard at Hotel Royale Chulan in Malaysia.

The capacity of the power plant, however, depends on the quantity of such wastes, officials said.

The companies will go for more biomass power plants in Dhaka and other cities after necessary feasibility studies if the pilot project turns out to be successful, they said.
