Ranga later apologised to Ershad for his comments.

Infrastructure dearth hampering dev

World Bank, said they want to life people

out of poverty, and for this jobs need to be provided to the poverty-stricken people. Most of the jobs need to come from the

private sector, he added.

Economist Zahid Hussain, Vice Chancellor of East Delta University Pro-Sekander Khan, and CCCI officials, among others, were present.

United work to end

Speaking as chief guest at the closing session, Law Commission Chairman Justice ABM Khairul Haque said South Asian people needed more access to neighbouring countries to know each other better, to know others' culture to understand the human rights issues.

For this, he stressed the need for visa-free movement in South Asia.

"We have to have the message of human rights in our hearts. We must feel for the oppressed, for the human being. We must not leave it [the problem] to others but sort it out by ourselves," he said.

In his closing remarks, NHRC Chairman Prof Mizanur Rahman described the human rights issues in South Asia as a common concern and urged the countries to deal with it collectively.

Increase reserved seats

The rights group called upon the government to fulfil their demand in the ongoing session of parliament and keep budgetary allocation for female lawmakers to help them carry out their duties.

Calling the BMP demands rational, former vice chancel lor of Chittagong University Prof Abdul Mannan stressed the need for enhancing women's participation in election as voters.

Mahfuz Anam, editor and publisher of The Daily Star, also expressed solidarity with the call, and urged BMP to unite women and work as a "voting block" to force political parties to fulfil their demands.




