Outsiders confine youth to DU hall for ransom

Police rescued a youth from Jagannath Hall of Dhaka University yesterday, 24 hours after two youths confined and tortured him in a room of the dormitory demanding ransom.

Sukumar Joardar, who claims to be a chauffeur. said he came to the hall premises to play on Tuesday afternoon when Udoy Saha and Johny Paul forced him into Room 229 in Jyotirmoy Guha Thakurta Bhaban and demanded money for buying an iPhone, the victim told The Daily Star at Shahbagh Police Station.

University sources said Udoy Saha is the younger brother of Utpal Saha, a former BCL leader at Jagannath Hall, and Johny Paul is the son of a staff at the dormitory. Although not a student of DU, Udoy has been living in the hall for over five years, they said.

Sukumar said the youths were known to him and that they took away his phone.

Police said they were informed by Sukumar's family.

Udoy and Johny went into hiding.



wheel was bent and immovable. With frustration and another 6km to go before I reach home, I asked the driver of the police vehicle, "Look what you have done!"

"Ididn't hit your cycle," he retorted.

"So how did the rear wheel get bent?" "I hit your leg, not your cycle," he replied without any

remorse. "Isn't it an even more serious offence? At least you

should say sorry!" my frustration was evident. Suddenly a seemingly higher official sitting in the back seat in plainclothes with a walkie-talkie in his hand came in defence of

the driver. In a rude tone, he said, "Hey you! He admitted that he hit you! What else do you want? Clear off now!" The insolence of a highly educated man (I assume) who

earns his bread through the taxes we pay stunned me. I asked, "So you are telling admitting a fault with rudeness means seeking apology?" Heyelled again, "Yes. You can go now!"

Then I took my cycle onto the road island, tried to fix it

and saw them drive away. I went back home with a question in mind, "Is it the decency of a 'friendly police force' as they claim?" I did not seek any compensation; all I expected was a polite apology, at least from the official.
