16 foreigners deported for illegal stay

5 more held in Dhaka, Ctg

Police on Tuesday arrested 16 illegal aliens of four countries and deported them the very day.

Of them, eight were Taiwanese, three Chinese, four Turkish and one was from Cameroon.

A team of Special Branch of Police made the arrests raiding several homes in Uttara and Banashree area of the capital, said sources in SB.

All of them were overstaying in the county with expired passports and visas. The Chinese and Taiwanese were allegedly involved in illegal Voice Over Internet Protocol business.

With these, a total of 25 foreigners had been deported this month. The crackdown on illegal aliens began after an illegal Algerian allegedly killed a teenager in Uttara in early October.

Meanwhile, Rapid Action Battalion arrested three foreigners at a house in Uttara yesterday while detectives arrested two more in Chittagong.

Zadi Josheph, 57, from Ivory Coast, Nigerian Agodi Francis Kanu John, 41, and Zambian Andrew Mulenga, 49, were arrested at Uttara-10. They could not show valid documents like passports, visas and work permits, said Major Mohammad Sadiqur Rahman, deputy director of Rab-1 at a press briefing at Rab-1 headquarters.

In Chittagong, detectives arrested two foreigners at Chawkbazar area yesterday in connection with deceiving people with counterfeit dollars.

Dhaka, Delhi plan hunt for JMB men

Simultaneous raids on border soon

Bangladesh and India have planned simultaneous raids along the border to nab the hiding members of the outlawed Jama'atul Mujahideen Bangladesh (JMB).

Prior to launching the drive, both sides will verify the information and lists of criminals exchanged between the two countries during the two-day meeting that ended in Dhaka on Tuesday, said sources in home ministry.

Talking to The Daily Star, Kamal Uddin Ahmed, senior additional home secretary, said: "We are scrutinising the information received from India. We need to know which information is necessary for us."

Kamal is the chief of a six-member Bangladesh team that will work on militancy and extend support to India's National Investigation Agency (NIA) in its investigation.

57pc people have access to safe toilet

About 57 percent of the people in Bangladesh have access to improved sanitation facilities but three percent still defecate out in the open, said Bangladesh Wash Alliance on World Toilet Day yesterday.

Even though three percent of the population still defecate out in the open, in neig-

bouring India, 50 percent of the people do the same, according to a World Health Organisation report released in May.

About 14 percent of the world's population do not have access to a proper toilet. More people have mobile phones than access to safe toilets, says the WHO.
