# Training, monitoring must of microcredit recipients

Discussion told

It is necessary to properly train and monitor people receiving interest free microcredit from the government, speakers said at a discussion at the social services department yesterday.

They also emphasised the need to involve local people, and ensure proper coordination among the ministries and departments to make the Rural Social Services (RSS) programme successful.

The Ministry of Social Welfare arranged the discussion "Social Media Adda" where 18 deputy commissioners of the country and about 3,000 people participated through Skype.

Nasima Begum, secretary to the social welfare ministry, said they will start the RSS programme at seven upazilas in the seven divisions as a pilot scheme.

She said under the RSS programme, a baseline survey would be conducted to identify people living below the poverty line, and work which is suitable for them.

"We will also see to their [povertystricken people | need for microcredit and other assistance," she added.

She said the social ministry would provide microcredit to those people who could not get loans from other concerned departments due to shortage of funds.

The government's target is to make Bangladesh a middle-income country by 2012, said Abul Kalam Azad, senior secretary to the PMO, who moderated the programme.

bodies' were taken to the Sri Aman Hospital. Police identified the injured Bangladeshis as Md Jakir, 36, and Maha Bubur, 26. However, officials at Bangladesh High Commission in Kuala Lumpur could

not confirm the identities. The fire started about 450m below the tunnel's entrance of the coal mine located about 3km from the Kuching-Sri Aman main road in Sarawak province at 8:45am when 119 miners, including 10 Bangladeshis, were working.

The blast was believed to have been caused by sparks from a faulty extractor fan which leaked gas, causing an explosion in a 69m-deep tunnel.

"There was an explosion when a switch for the conveyor belt was turned on," Sri Aman Fire and Rescue Department Chief Ranger Moos said.

The mine has been closed until the Department's Hazardous Materials Team evaluates the safety of the tunnel.

The last explosion at a coal mine in the state killed four Chinese nationals in Abok in 2012.

# Man found dead in hotel in capital

According to the hotel authorities, three men had rented the room in the morning, and the murdered man was one of them. Since the incident, the other two did not contact the hotel.


