#### 3RD PLACE: SHAIKH MOHIR UDDIN




I've been doing professional level photography since 1994.

#### 1ST PLACE: SIPRA GOSWAMI




I have been doing this for the past two years. But have been writing stories, poems since childhood. Songs are my obsession. I would also love to work with children.
