ITUATED off of Gulshan Avenue, The Farmer's Market is a new food venture that plays different roles by day and by night. By day, it is a casual hangout spot where you can enjoy some light dishes for lunch. By night, lights illuminate the outdoor area and it turns into the perfect chilling spot for winter evenings.

The Farmer's Market opened its doors in mid-October, just in time for that lovely preamble to the winter, when sitting outdoors is not just possible, but pleasant. The menu is, like the rest of the eatery, growing at a slow and steady rate.

The Farmer's Market features its own menu, as well as dishes from Break Express and a few select waffle choices from Yellow Submarine Cafe, which both operate from

their carts. On Friday mornings, you can find handpicked fresh, organic vegetables from

Organo by Greenthumb and formalin-free, freshly caught fish from Bhairab Fish and Co. The vegetables are sourced from organic farmers around Dhaka and the gardens of farming enthusiasts who grow their own produce on their vacant plots.

The idea is to introduce the concept of a "farmer's market" in a concrete jungle such as Dhaka. In a typical farmer's market, farmers bring the fresh fruits, vegeta-

bles and other products grown and prepared in their own farms, and sell it to the public. Customers who are lovers of fresh produce and keen on maintaining a healthy lifestyle visit these markets, in order to purchase goods straight from the source.
