# Cartoon exhibition, Meet the faces

Venue: Alliance Française, La Gallaria The 1st solo Cartoon Exhibition by Nasreen Sultana Mitu will be held at Alliance Francaise. Nasreen Sultana Mitu has been drawing cartoons and caricatures professionally since 2006. She began cartooning in Unmad magazine under the direct supervision of the legendary cartoonist, editor and publisher of Unmad magazine Mr Ahsan Habib. Mitu is now an Assistant Editor for the same magazine. In 2010, Mitu started her career as a political cartoonist for the Daily New Age. After the 2013 Rana Plaza incident, her cartoon immediately went viral on social media. The cartoon was featured prominently in public television.

Mitu found her métier for drawing caricature in 2011. Her extraordinary and unorthodox interpretation of human faces is a celebrated item in the social media. In Bangladesh, caricatures mostly mock and criticise the political leaders but Mitu sees it as an exclusive form of art that conveys human characteristics beyond the boundaries of politics and pop culture. This year, her exhibition Meet the Faces, is going to take place as the first ever solo caricature exhibition in Bangladesh.
