In a week or two

Minister changes his forecast of 2-3 years

Bangladesh Food Safety Authority will be formed in a week or two, Food Minister Quamrul Islam said yesterday, boosting optimism that food adulterators would be brought to book.

"The process to appoint a chairman and four members

[of the authority] is underway," he told a workshop at the city's Cirdap auditorium. The food ministry in association with Food and

Agriculture Organization (FAO) organised the event on

"Institutionalisation of Food Safety in Bangladesh". Quamrul said all the 13 line ministries will coordinate on food safety to ensure safety at all levels, including production, import, processing, stock, supply, marketing,

The minister had earlier said implementation of the Food Safety Act, 2013 would take two to three years.

He, however, did not specify a timeframe for finalising the regulations, which is essential to enforce the law.

Travellers on Dhaka-Chittagong highway were stranded for five hours yesterday after transport workers blocked the road protesting pro-ruling party men's extortion from buses and attack on the workers.

Buses were parked blocking the highway at several places in Comilla around noon, creating a 20km-long tailback on the country's busiest highway.

"I boarded a bus from Shashongasa Bus Terminal with my ailing father to visit a doctor in Dhaka and we were stuck at Alekhachar for hours. The bus had to return to the terminal," said Shahidul Islam, who is the chairman of the political

Anger boils in NYC

New York mayor Bill de Blasio appealed for calm yesterday after a night of angry protests over a grand jury's decision not to charge a white police officer in the choking death of a black man.

Police said 83 people were arrested overnight, most for disorderly conduct, after protesters converged on Rockefeller Center and the city's iconic Times Square chanting: "No justice, no peace."

Another demonstration was called for later yesterday outside the headquarters of the New York Police Department, and the city's liberal mayor called on protesters to keep them peaceful.

return from Lebanon



She lost her mother at birth. She left her deceitful husband four months after marriage. Even so, she thought a better life was possible. So she rested her hope on an overseas job.

As Sharmin Akter, 25, established contact with Nipa, an agent for Bangladeshi female migrant workers in Lebanon, she barely knew what lay in wait for her would put the final nail in her coffin. She had flown to Lebanon in April this

year. Two weeks after she started a job as a domestic help, Nipa talked her into leaving her employer for a more lucrative job.
