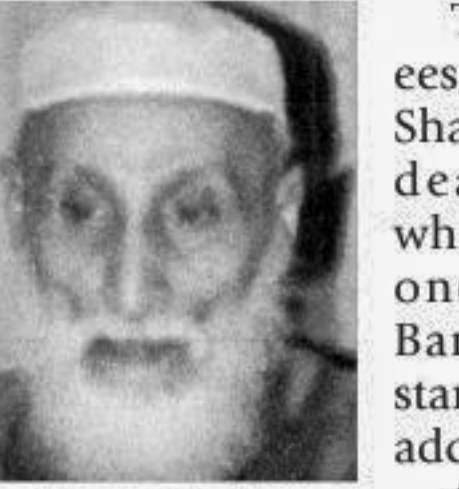
DNCC starts distributing holding numbers, digitisation
