PM appraises president on recent foreign trips

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina called on President Abdul Hamid at Bangabhaban in the capital yesterday for half an hour from around 7:15pm, appraising him of the outcome of her recent visits to Nepal and Malaysia and discussing on Hamid's upcoming one to India and the country's latest political situation.

Hamid thanked Hasina for her visits to Kathmandu on November 25 to attend the 18th Saarc Summit and Malaysia from December 2 to 4, said Hamid's Press Secretary Ihsanul Karim and Prime Minister's Office sources.

Benoît-Pierre Laramée new Canadian envoy

Benoît-Pierre Laramée has been appointed as the new Canadian high commissioner to Bangladesh. The new high commissioner will arrive in Dhaka shortly after the departure of the outgoing envoy Heather Cruden on January 14 next year, according to a press release of the Canadian High Commission. Prior to his appointment in Bangladesh, Laramée served as high commissioner to Cameroon. Meanwhile, Heather Cruden yesterday called on three cabinet members including Foreign Minister AH Mahmood Ali.

7 Hizb-ut Tahrir men remanded

The arrestees are Tanmoy Sufian, Ariful Islam, Safayet Yasin, Md Raihan, Iftekharul, Ali Mohammed Bilawal, and Nur Mohammed.

WAR CRIMES IN KISHOREGANJ

Another narrates Hasan Ali's Hindu killing spree

Corroborating the first prosecution witness, the second one yesterday narrated the September 9, 1971 killing during the Liberation War of 12 people, including his father, in Kishoreganj's Shimulhati village led by the same man wearing a white "tupi" (prayer cap) and with a "sharp, pointed beard", whom he also later heard from villagers was fugitive accused Syed Md Hasan Ali.

Moreover, on the killing of two of the 12, Okkur Paul and Sharat Paul, Somendra Chandra Paul, 57, said he had heard two shots after they were taken to Jogodish Paul's house whereas the first witness, Renu Chandra Paul, stated to have seen the bodies at the residence.

His father was standing next to Dharoni Paul, the one at the extreme south, while the rest 10 were lined up east of a residence, Mir

Bari, and shot, said Somendra, adding that he too had seen Renu's father bolting for a nearby jute field, where he was hunted down and shot dead.

The villagers set the bodies afloat the water body, Verontola Beel, after the looting and torching of houses by the same "Razakars", auxiliary forces of the Pakistani occupation army, numbering around 8-10 with khakis and rifles and arriving on a boat and including the "tupi" man who ordered killing Hindus, said Somendra.

All this while he too had hid in a jungle, he stated during the one-hour deposition before the three-member International Crimes Tribunal-1 led by Justice M Enayetur Rahim.

State-appointed defence counsel Abus Shukur Khan cross-examined the witness and proceedings were adjourned until today.

2 pedestrians hurt in iron sheet fall

Quoting locals police said Imi Akhter, 22, of Sitakunda upazila, got married to Md Harun, an expatriate, one and a-half month earlier.

Following an altercation Harun hit Imi on her forehead with an electric iron. Neighbours caught Harun and rushed Imi to a private clinic where doctors declared her dead, added police.

Woman burnt for dowry dies

A woman who was allegedly burnt by her husband for more dowry died at Dhaka Medical College Hospital yesterday after struggling for 19 days.

Khadija Akter Sumi, 23, was a mother of one. Her husband Md Sopon Miah with his family first beat her until she fainted and then burnt her as she refused to fulfil the family's demand of Tk 5 lakh by giving Tk 3 lakh more, said police.

Sopon is absconding but his mother Ayesha Khatun and sister Parvin Akter were arrested.

Jamaat man hurt in factional gunfight

A Jamaat-e-Islami activist Abdul Mabud sustained bullet wounds in a gunfight between his group and another faction led by Bashar at Ewchiya union Satkania upazila in Chittagong early yesterday over establishing supremacy in the area.

Satkania police, who arrested Abdul, 33, son of Abdur Rashid of the union, said he is accused in 15 cases, including for murder. He is undergoing treatment at Chittagong Medical College Hospital. Bashar could not be contacted over the phone.
