SYNC.ME

Sync.ME is a contact app that syncs your contacts with social media. When it comes to synchronising your phone's contact list with your Facebook friends list, this app is like magic. It predicts the matches without matching every word or every letter of the name, and you can rectify the errors, if any. In cases where the app cannot come up with a prediction, you can manually match your contact to their rightful Facebook profile.

The perks are quite a few. First off, you'll never forget your friends' birthday. Sync.ME will give you birthday alerts if you choose the option for it. Next, their profile pictures will automatically pop up on your phone screen every time you call them or vice versa, and makes your life easier searching for them on the contact list too. You can also view their profiles at the push of a button.

One interesting feature is the in-call experience. Whenever you're on the phone

with someone synced by Sync.ME and your internet is on, their latest updates will appear on your screen, if you enable the option. And lately the app developers added another simple feature, using which you can share entire photo albums with particular contacts from within the app, and even photo chat with them.

Sync.ME doesn't require the contact number of your Facebook friend on the site to predict the matches. Secondly, Sync.ME can also connect to your LinkedIn account and predict matches from there as well – so even if you are associated with someone professionally who is not on your Facebook, you can still stay up to date about them without having to log in to your LinkedIn every day.

The app is very intuitive and easy to use. Its size varies according to your device and it's free for both Android and iOS with an average rating of 4.5/5 on both the platforms. I've tried quite a few contact syncing apps, and undoubtedly Sync.ME is the best I've stumbled upon.
