Tension between Bangalees and Biharis (Urdu speaking people) was soaring since the historic March 7 speech of Bangabandhu in 1971. There were clashes at places, including in Dinajpur and Rangpur, the strongholds of the Biharis who favoured a united Pakistan.

HC summons heads of 26 schools

The High Court yesterday summoned the heads of 26 schools in Dhaka to appear before it on January 6 for taking additional fees from candidates of Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examinations.

The headmasters or principals and chairs or managing directors of each of the institutions and their governing bodies have to appear before the HC by 10:30am that day to explain why they charged the candidates more than the government-fixed amount.

The HC bench of Justice Quazi Reza-Ul Hoque and Justice Abu Taher Md Saifur Rahman passed the orders after a hearing on a suo moto rule it issued earlier.

UN climate talks finally strike deal

Govts pledge to submit national plans on emission cuts by March 2015

About 190 nations agreed yesterday the building blocks of a new-style global deal due in 2015 to combat climate change amid warnings that far tougher action will be needed to limit increases in global temperatures.

Under the deal reached in Lima, governments will submit national plans for reining

in greenhouse gas emissions by an informal deadline of March 31, 2015 to form the basis of a global agreement due at a summit in Paris in a year's time. Most of the tough decisions about how to slow climate

change were postponed until then. "Much remains to be done in Paris next year," French Foreign Minister Laurent Fabius said. The texts, agreed two days into overtime after two weeks

The latest recruit of US Navy

The US Navy has revealed its latest recruit - a giant robotic spy disguised as a tuna. The robo-fish is designed to swim into enemy territory, and to guard the hulls of US boats. It uses a robo-fin to move silently through the

water - and had been dubbed 'Silent Nemo' by Navy bosses.

Researchers from the Chief of Naval Operations Rapid Innovation Cell and Boston Engineering tested the prototype at the Joint Expeditionary Base Little Creek in Virginia on Thursday.
