







National Hackathon winners announced!



After 36 hours of marathon programming the national hackathon came to an end, where developers worked to bring about technological solutions to the 10 national problems. This event, the biggest of its kind, started last week at the Dhaka Institution of Diploma Engineers Bangladesh (IDEB). Ten teams have won in the 10 categories of national problems. To help implement their projects, Tk. 20 lakh of innovation fund is being provided by the ICT division.

The winners in each category are: for Traffic Jam Solution, team GravityBD from AUST University. For Road Safety, team Mobio Men from MobioApp Limited. For Cyclone Center Management, team UIU Ambassadors, from UIU University. For Sexual & Reproductive Health,



Protect Your Android

10 Tips for Maximum Security

The open and flexible nature of the Android mobile OS is what made it a leader in the mobile market, but it is also the basis for the notorious fragmentation issue that is often mentioned. While Android versions may differ, we have aggregated some general tips to ensure that your Android device is ultimately more secure.

1. Only download applications from the Google Play

2. Check the permissions that an application is seeking to use to make sure that they are appropriate for that 3. Use strong passwords!

4. Encrypt all of the data on your phone so even if it is

lost or stolen, the data cannot be accessed. 5. Try to avoid public Wi-Fi hotspots and run a regular



audit of your remembered Wi-Fi networks list. 6. Always use VPN, especially when using a public hotspot or an untrusted network connection. 7. Disable notifications that are likely to pop up even when your screen is locked.

8. Apply settings to Google services that will limit the information at risk should there be a data leak. 9. Rid yourself of unnecessary apps. More apps mean

more risk. 10. And finally, use two-factor authentication for Google and other apps to ensure maximum user account security.
