Alibaba boss taps up Taiwan youth amid protests

...... Anti-Beijing protesters chanted outside a high-level business meeting in Taiwan Monday where the founder of China's ecommerce giant Alibaba called on the island's youth to start businesses on the mainland.

Trade with China is a particularly sensitive topic as fears grow over the mainland's increased influence on Taiwan -- a factor which contributed to the ruling Beijing-friendly party's worst-ever polls defeat at recent local elections in Taiwan.

Alibaba founder Jack Ma, who recently became Asia's richest man, was addressing business leaders from China and Taiwan to tie in with an eight-day visit by a top Chinese envoy.

Dozens of pro-independence activists chanting "Chinese communists back to China!" and "Chinese communists are coming to trap Taiwan investors!" were held back by police barricades outside the two-day forum.

One was pushed to the ground as he tried to break through police lines and four protesters were taken away, but later released.

Ma, a former English teacher, started Alibaba in his apartment in 1999. He has seen his fortune balloon after a record-breaking \$25 billion initial public offering on the New York Stock Exchange in September.

Young people and small businesses are particularly incensed by trade deals between Taiwan and China that they feel have been agreed in secret and not benefited the ordinary Taiwanese public.

Taiwan and China split in 1949 at the end of a civil war, but Beijing still claims the island as part of its territory awaiting reunification -- by force if necessary.

Monday's meeting was attended by top business figures, including Morris Chang, chairman of Taiwan Semiconductor Manufacturing Co, the world's biggest contract microchip company.

As these sectors are considered as the promoter of private investment, it is expected that private investment will be revitalised with this investment.

Moreover, many backward and forward linkage industries linked with government investment will get opportunity to expand their business. The global economy is also coming out of the recession era which may encourage the private sector to invest more for participating in international trade. This expected surge in private investment will essentially escalate the demand for bank financing.

Planning for government borrowing from the banking sector on a large scale may also create pressure on banks which will siphon off the current excess liquidity. Apart from this, a hike in CRR (cash-reserve ratio), which may raise interest rate on loans, will also mop up liquidity from the market. However, as supply

sides of loan financing, banks and non-bank has undertaken multidimensional initiatives financial institutions may also take some steps to create demand for its excess funds. This can be done through ensuring uninterrupted credit flows to the agriculture sector, and small and medium enterprises together with other important existing and new sectors.

Apart from continuation of urban financing at a higher rate, banks may consider ensuring credit flow at a progressive rate in the rural area covering traditionally un-served farm and nonfarm SMEs and other innovative niche area entrepreneurs.

Businesses and productions such as rice bran oil, wooden business, agro-based industry, food industry, floriculture, light engineering and mushroom cultivation are gradually expanding in the semi-urban and rural areas where banks can finance increasingly.

Creating congenial business environment through controlling macroeconomic indicators, bringing down interest rate spread, introducing more and more refinancing schemes covering new areas of business, offering advocacy services to entrepreneurs, and imparting training to bank employees are some wellknown initiatives undertaken by the BB. Bangladesh Institute of Bank Management also plays a supportive role through its training, research and different types of advocacy services. It is expected that these collective initiatives will enable banks to find out the areas and sectors where the current excess liquidity will be utilised.
