North South University (NSU), the first private university in Bangladesh, was established under Private University Act -1992 (now amended as PUA-2010). The university was formally inaugurated on 10 February, 1993 by the then Prime Minister of Bangladesh. The Honorable President of the People's Republic of Bangladesh is the Chancellor of NSU. NSU is approved by the University Grants Commission (UGC), Bangladesh. The Computer Science & Engineering programs are under the process for


accreditation of ABET (Accrediting Board for Engineering and Technology).

The foundation of NSU state-of-the-art permanent campus at Bashundhara, Dhaka, Bangladesh was laid in 2003. The construction of the campus superstructures was completed in Summer 2009 and the university shifted to its spacious new campus. The 1.25 million sq. ft. floor space contains 120 classrooms, lecture theaters and exam halls equipped with latest teaching aids such as multimedia & computer terminal. It has Internet Protocol Telephone connectivity, fully automated library, administrative offices and faculty office rooms with modern facilities; Pharmacy and Life Sciences-Biotechnology, Microbiology & Biochemistry labs and computer labs with around 2000 PCs with Wi-Fi internet facilities. Servers include HP-UX System-5430, Sun Solaris-2800, IBM P series and DELL 2950.

The NSU follows the US higher education features such as semesters, credit hours, grades, etc. Its curricula of undergraduate economics, business and computer science, when first introduced, were largely modeled after the curricula of the University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign and duly approved by the University Grants Commission (UGC). 
