

3 robbers get death penalty for killing fellow

A Dhaka court yesterday sentenced three members of a robbery gang to death in a case filed for killing one of their fellows at a hotel in Old Dhaka in 2010.
It also fined Mohammad Rubel, Rony Biswas, 23, and Roman, 25, Tk 25,000 each, in default to suffer one year in jail.
According to the prosecution, they beheaded another Rubel on June 6 in that year and kept the head at Shah Kamal restaurant (later named Meem Hotel) to blackmail its owner.
However, their attempt was foiled when police arrested them.
The convicts killed him following an internal feud among them over disbursement of booties.
Sutrapur police pressed charges against the three on December 29, 2010 and the court indicted them on September 21, 2011.



A fire broke out in a coach of a train parked at the capital's Kamalapur station yesterday, gutting its furniture and all 68 seats. The cause behind the incident could not be ascertained immediately, said fire service sources. A five-member probe committee was formed and asked to submit its report within five working days.

5 held for raping girl in capital

Police yesterday arrested five youths for allegedly raping a 16-year-old girl in the capital's Darus Salam area.
Rafiqul Islam, officer-in-charge of Darus Salam Police Station, said five men threatened the victim with a video of her having sex with her fiancé, who was a friend of the miscreants.
On Sunday, they took the girl to an under-construction building and threatened her that they would make the video public if she did not engage in sexual activities with them, Rafiqul added quoting the victim.
He said the five secretly videoed their friend having sex with the victim on Thursday.
The victim filed a case against eight persons, including her fiancé, with the police station on Monday night.
Police could not recover the video yet.
The girl has been admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital's One-stop Crisis Centre for tests and legal aid.

Khaleda reinstates last expelled JCD dissenter

BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia yesterday ordered reinstatement of a Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal leader, who had been expelled along with two others for opposing the student body's new central committee.
Gazi Md Rezwan ul Hossain Reaz, joint secretary of the last central committee, was expelled on November 10 for "breaching organisational discipline", says a JCD press release. On Sunday, former vice-president Abu Sayeed and ex-organising secretary Anisur Rahman Talukder Khokan were reinstated in the organisation.
JCD insiders said the decision was taken to muster strength for BNP's upcoming anti-government movement and enhance participation in Khaleda's December 27 rally in Gazipur.
Meanwhile, in a letter, five other JCD leaders who were served show-cause notices on November 10 for the same reason apologised on Monday and vowed to work for the organisation.
Khaleda approved a 201-member partial committee of JCD on October 14 with Rajib Hsain as president and Akramul Hasan as general secretary but some leaders who did not get leadership positions vehemently opposed it and led demonstrations, demanding its dissolution.
The three were expelled after BNP acting secretary general Mirza Fakhru Islam Alamgir and Dhaka city convener Mirza Abbas failed to tame them.

Central jail to go to Keraniganj by June

Says prime minister

Dhaka Central Jail will be shifted to Keraniganj from Lalbagh by June next year, and the nine acres of land of the existing prison will be utilised by constructing a park and two museums for the public, said Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina.
She made the announcement while inaugurating "Kara Saptaha-2014 (prison week-2014)" at Kashimpur Prison Campus Parade Field in Gazipur yesterday.
Congratulating the prison officials and employees marking the Kara Week the prime minister said the week is being observed after a span of seven years.
Hasina said the Awami League government, after taking office in 1996, had taken projects for construction of 36 prisons in the country.
She said the two museums will be opened, after relocation of the central jail, to the public so that people can know about the jail life of the nation's great leaders.
The prime minister also announced that "Gallantry Award" would be introduced for the jail keepers for their outstanding work.

Qaisar's DEATH SENTENCE Gonojagoron Mancha demands quick execution

Both the factions of Gonojagoron Mancha yesterday brought out separate processions demanding quick execution of the death sentence on war criminal Syed Mohammad Qaisar, a former state minister.
Imran H Sarker, leader of a faction, said many of the verdicts by the International Crimes Tribunals are yet to be executed, and such a trend of delaying the executions has raised questions in people's minds.
Justice cannot be done to the martyrs till execution of the verdicts, Imran added.
Referring to the pending execution of Kamaruzzaman's death sentence, Imran said it had also been brought to a halt because of the pleas of different international human rights organisations.
Imran's faction gathered at the capital's Shahbagh while the other led by Kamal Pasha rallied before the Bangladesh National Museum.
Qaisar was given death penalty on seven charges of killing and rape during the Liberation War.

People with disabilities need job opportunities

Persons with disabilities need opportunities for work not sympathy, said speakers at a workshop yesterday.
These people make up 1.6 crore of the population, and so with proper training, a large workforce would be created that can contribute to the country's GDP, they added.
The workshop titled "Employment Opportunity for the Person with Disabilities" was organised in the capital's LGED Bhaban by the Centre for Disability in Development (CDD), and Blind Education and Rehabilitation Development Organisation (BERDO) with assistance from Australian AID and CBM, Bangladesh.
Dr Khondaker Showkat Hossain, director general of the National Academy for Planning and Development, said it is the government's duty to train people with disabilities according to their capability.
Abdul Jalil Bhuyian, secretary general of the Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalists, said people with disabilities are able to perform better than others as long as they can get work which is compatible with their ability.
Abdul Hai, a physically challenged man from Narayananganj, said he has been building frames of rickshaw since 1998.
Hai said recently he employed a man who has one arm and taught him how to paint rickshaws. "People like me can work better if the job matches their ability," he added.

Zeaul new DG of immigration

Road accidents kill six

Six people were killed and 20 others injured in road accidents in the country yesterday and Monday.
Our Rangpur correspondent reports, two people died and 10 others were injured when a bus hit a truck from behind on Rangpur-Dhaka highway at Chak-Sholagari in Pirganj upazila yesterday.
The dead are Riad Babu, 14, of Baro Mirjarup village and Shariful Islam, 32, of Gaibandha.
In Noakhali, Humayun Kabir of Mohammadpur village died when a tractor hit his motorcycle at Teker Bazar of Senbagh upazila on Monday.
Our Gaibandha correspondent reports, two died and 10 others were injured when a bus collided head-on with a truck on Bogra-Rangpur highway at Shallowpara in Palashbari upazila yesterday.
The deceased were Shariful Islam, 28, of Hasanganj village and Motiur Rahman, 33, of Satbari village.
Our Mymensingh correspondent adds, Bachchu Miah, 32, died when a truck ran him over while crossing Dhaka-Mymensingh highway at Seed Store in Bhaluka yesterday.

BNP chairperson is proved guilty, she will get punishment", Fakhru said it was a "political" statement, unbecoming of a person holding the constitutional post.
Recently, Judge Bashudev Roy who was hearing the cases was transferred after Khaleda petitioned the High Court, expressing "no confidence" in him. Law Ministry's Joint Secretary Abu Ahmed Jamadar replaced Basudev, and the government called it a "routine" transfer.
Fakhru said the replacement at the time when a petition was still to be disposed of by the HC revealed the government's "evil and political intention".
Khaleda will testify in the graft cases before a makeshift court at Bakshibazar today, her counsel said, when party activists are expected to gather nearby to exhibit their might.
