thousand people were critically injured or maimed in the crashes caused by these vehicles, mostly illegal.

The highest 64 accidents occurred in September, killing 52 and wounding 316, making it the most fatal month. March saw the lowest number of accidents--27, but February marked the lowest number of casualties--13 deaths and 66 injuries -- in 28 accidents.

PWAB also identified a lack of pedestrian crossings and footbridges, separate lanes based on vehicle speeds, and awareness among pedestrians as other reasons. "We urge the authorities to build zebra crossings and

footbridges in the city, go tough on reckless driving and unlicensed drivers, and raise public awareness," said Mozammel Haque. "We will place our recommendations at the forthcoming

meeting of Jatiya Sarak Nirapatta Council." In order to curb accidents, drivers should be trained

through institutes, said Ilias Kanchan, a safe road activist and Chairman of Nirapad Sarak Chai. "In most cases, novices learn driving from their seniors,

but this is not the proper way," he said. "These drivers also get licences. The practice must stop." Apart from the drivers, he said, those who are liable for

faulty road construction and those who give fitness certificates to unfit vehicles must be brought to book. Shafiqul Islam, deputy inspector general of police,

Chittagong zone, told The Daily Star that their teams regularly counselled drivers on safe practices at different terminals. Pointing out that transport workers make up a significant portion of the casualties, the official said, "By showing instances,

we try to get the drivers understand how terribly a family suffers when a member is killed or injured in an accident." Regarding reckless driving, he said, "There is no speedometer on our highways.... highway police cannot work properly for lacking logistics.

Chittagong city Mayor M Manjur Alam said there were six footbridges in the city but pedestrians were reluctant to use those. "People should use the prevailing facilities." He added, "If the traffic department (of police) provides us a list of spots that need zebra crossings, the city corporation will build them within a week."

Police sent the body to Chittagong Medical College morgue for autopsy. The body bore injury marks on different parts including the face, head, ear, shoulder, hands and chest, the morgue sources said, adding that he was beaten and tortured before his death.

Nurul Alam, officer-in-charge of Double Mooring Police Station, said it was clear that the man was tortured to death.

In a drive to arrest the accused, police found the centre locked. All the staff and the director Jahangir Alam Joni, who runs the centre, are on the run, the OC said.

Dr Ashok said although India is called the capital of the world's heart disease, he was more worried about Bangladesh as the situation seems worse here. He attributes the situation to bad food habits. "In Bangladesh, food is too rich and oily,

unfortunately even the food cooked at home," Dr Ashok said and suggested a change in the eating system. "People's daily diet consists of meat, fried

food and polao; sometimes these food are even eaten three times a day -- for breakfast, lunch and dinner." He advised all, including those who

think themselves to be healthy, to follow three rules: do regular exercise for forty minutes, avoid all oily food and give up smoking.

Dr Ashok suggested enacting laws against trans fat, which is used in making many food items such as cakes and biscuits, but is very harmful to health.

"Awareness about healthy food and lifestyle has to start at school. You cannot change habits when you are old."

### Missing youth found dead in capital

### 90,000 Yaba tablets seized in Ctg port

Bangladesh Navy seized 90,000 Yaba tablets worth Tk 4.5 crore from a boat at the outer anchorage of Chittagong Port yesterday.

While patrolling the area navy ship "Nirbhik" chased the wooden boat finding its movement suspicious at 12:45am, officials of Narcotics Control Department quoted the navy personnel as saying.

Four to five men of the boat jumped off it and swam away. Later, navy personnel found the Yaba pills in the boat.
