

Muggers shoot cop in Sylhet

Two persons mugged

Muggers snatched away Tk 13.5 lakh from the manager of RAK Ceramic's show room while a trader was mugged of Tk 5 lakh in Sylhet city yesterday.

In Mendibagh area, four muggers on motorcycles stopped Syed Foisal Ahmed, manager of the show room, while he was going to State Bank of India's Sylhet branch in a car, said police.

Later, 20 cohorts of the muggers gathered there and started vandalising the vehicle. They fired gunshots and snatched the gun of the bank's guard, accompanying Foisal, before snatching the money, added police.

In Mazumdarui area, muggers stabbed a police official as he tried to catch them while they were fleeing after mugging Tk 5 lakh from a trader.

Five muggers stopped Lokman Ahmed of Jatapur area, while he was going to Airport Road area in an auto-rickshaw after withdrawing the money from a bank.

While the muggers were fleeing with the money, Arif, assistant sub-inspector of Airport Police Station, attempted to catch them and got stabbed.

BNP Senior Vice-Chairman Tarique Rahman, addressing a programme BNP's London unit organised in East London on December 15 marking Victory Day, said Bangabandhu was a "big Razakar for having banned the Awami League himself dubbing it as a party of thieves".

Addressing a press briefing at BNP's Naya Paltan central office, Rizvi, who recently met Tarique in London, said

Hasina's government was panicking seeing Khaleda's popularity as a huge number of people were attending her rallies around the country.

Pointing to Jubo Dal chief Moazzem Hossain Alal's arrest on Saturday night, Rizvi said the government claimed that it was not worried about BNP's agitation.

"If it is true, why are they conducting countrywide drives to arrest opposition men? Why did they arrest Alal?

Why police are conducting operations in BNP leaders' houses to arrest them?"

"Because the government's position is very vulnerable. They become fearful of losing power when they hear about our upcoming movement," Rizvi said.

Demanding release of Alal and BNP Standing Committee Member Goyeshwar Chandra Roy, Rizvi called upon the party's people to stay on the streets to make the 20-party alliance's countrywide hartal today a success.

death and the January 5 national election.

The documentary also linked these incidents to activities of terrorist outfits such as Ansarullah Bangla Team and ISIS and presented interviews of two alleged terrorists.

"Documentaries on the (war crimes) tribunal, including videos of testimonies, should be made," said Shahriar, adding that the government should create a separate fund for

production of films related to the spirit of the Liberation War.

Addressing as chief guest, Information Minister Hasaul Haq Inu said, "We had only primarily resisted the torment perpetrated by terrorist supporters last year but the danger has not disappeared."

He said BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia patronises collaborators, war criminals and terrorist but a section of people were in a dilemma about it.

"The intellectual community remains silent on this issue," he said, adding that it was time to choose between democracy and terrorism.

Bangladesh Mahila Parishad President Ayesha Khanom, Institute of Architects former president Rabiul Hussain and the nirmul committee Vice President Shyamoli Nasrin Chowdhury also spoke at the programme, chaired by eminent journalist and cultural activist Kalam Lohani.

2 killed in water tank wall collapse

Two people were killed and two others injured as a wall of a water tank collapsed on them in Siddirganj of Narayanganj district yesterday afternoon.

The deceased were Abdur Rab, 80, Jharna Akter, 50, while the injured are Shuraya Akter, 8, and Doly Akter, 7.

Police and locals said the wall of the water tank of a house in Godail Nayapara area fell down leaving Jharna, a tenant, dead on the spot.

Critically injured Abdur Rab succumbed to his injuries on the way to Dhaka Medical College Hospital. Shuraya and Doly were admitted to DMCH.

journalists and cultural personalities, the delegation talked to indigenous people, Bangalee settlers, law enforcers and local administration officials, said the assistant professor of Jagannath University while reading out a written statement at the press conference.

The rights activists placed a five-point demand including amending the CHT land dispute resolution commission act, impartial investigation into the attack and trial of the attackers, full implementation of the CHT peace accord and ensuring security for the indigenous people.

Noted columnist Syed Abul Maksud said repeated attacks on indigenous people were being carried out under state patronisation. He also threatened to launch a movement if the latest attackers were not tried within one week.

Veteran politician Pankaj Bhattacharya said mass resistance must be formed against continuous attacks and repression on indigenous people.

Academician Prof Ajoy Roy, Dhaka University teacher Robaet Ferdous and women's rights activist Khushi Kabir also spoke.

Two workers die from electrocution

Two construction workers died from electrocution while another was injured at Islambagh of Old Dhaka yesterday.

Asadul, 20, and Khada, 26, were declared dead at Dhaka Medical College Hospital from where Md Rubel took treatment.

The incident occurred when five workers lifted an iron rod which accidentally touched a live wire of a nearby electric pole, said Rubel, adding that the two others did not get hurt as they were in sandals. The bodies are kept at the hospital morgue for autopsies, said police.
