Victory Day celebration at Dhaka Residential Model College

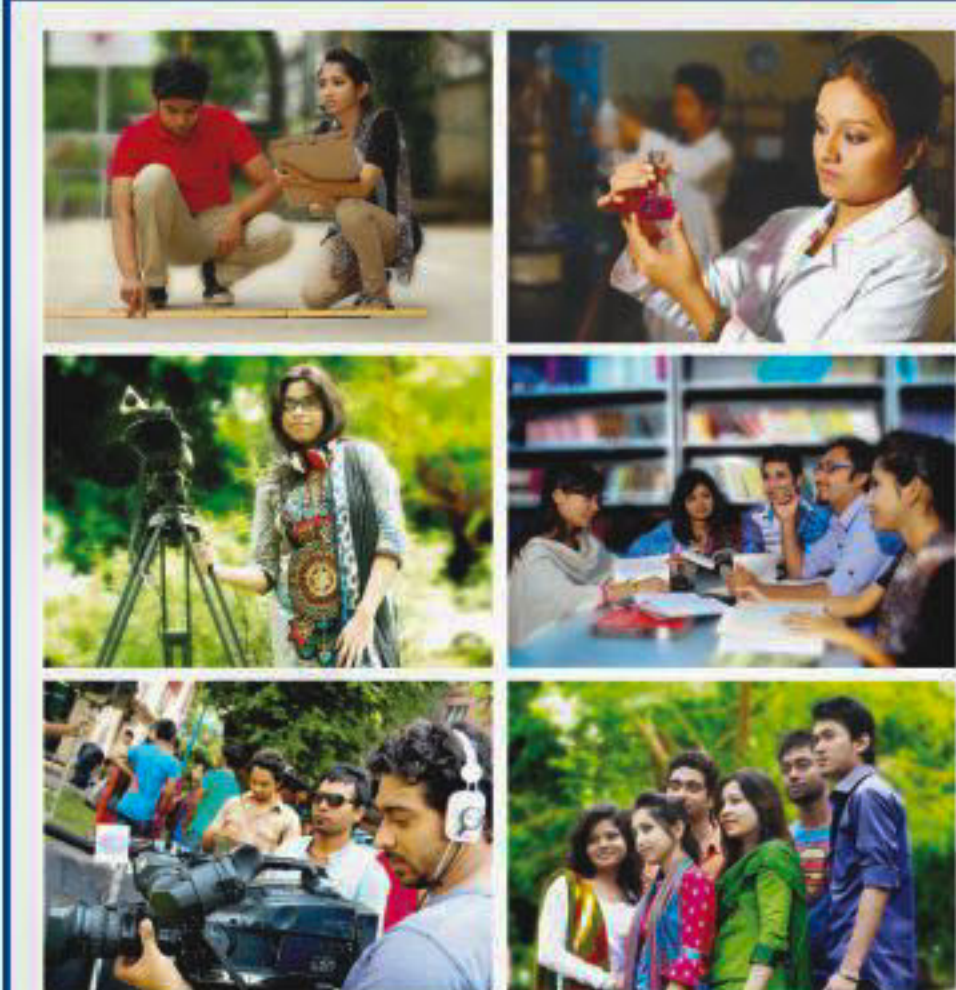


Victory Day 2014 was celebrated with due respect at Dhaka Residential Model College.
