Nobel Peace Prize Winner Dr. Muhammad Yunus received a Global Entrepreneurship Award in the best leading figure category. He was also ranked fifth in the Global Thought Leader 2014 survey.



In 2014, the government of India conferred the Padma Bhushan, third highest civilian honour, on Prof. Anisuzzaman; the first such award for any Bangladeshi.



Sir Fazle Hasan Abed, founder of BRAC, won the 2014 Trust Women Awards at a ceremony held at the Trust Women Conference in London.



Saber Chowdhury MP was elected President of the Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU).



Speaker Shirin Sharmin Chaudhury became the first Bangladeshi to be elected the chairperson of Commonwealth Parliamentary Association (CPA).



Saima Wazed Hossain, daughter of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina was awarded by the World Health Organization for her contributions in fighting against neuro-development disorder and autism.



Wasfia Nazreen, the second Bangladeshi woman to conquer Mount Everest, was named as one of the National Geographic's Adventurers of the Year in recognition of her achievement in empowering Bangladesh's women and girls through her campaign.



Shahabuddin Ahmed, a renowned Bangladeshi artist living in Paris, was awarded the French title "Chevalier de l'Ordre des Arts et des Lettres" (Knight in the Order of the Arts and Literature).
