But 10 days after its release, the distributors of the film seem to have a different story to tell. A distributor claimed that Lingaa was a disaster of epic proportions at box office and he, including several other distributors, has lost a huge sum due to Lingaa's poor performance. In fact, the distributor went on to say that Thalaivar's film has failed to collect even 20% of their investment. Lingaa is directed by K.S. Ravikumar. The film stars Rajinikanth playing dual role, Jagapati Babu, Anushka Shetty and Sonakshi Sinha in lead roles.
