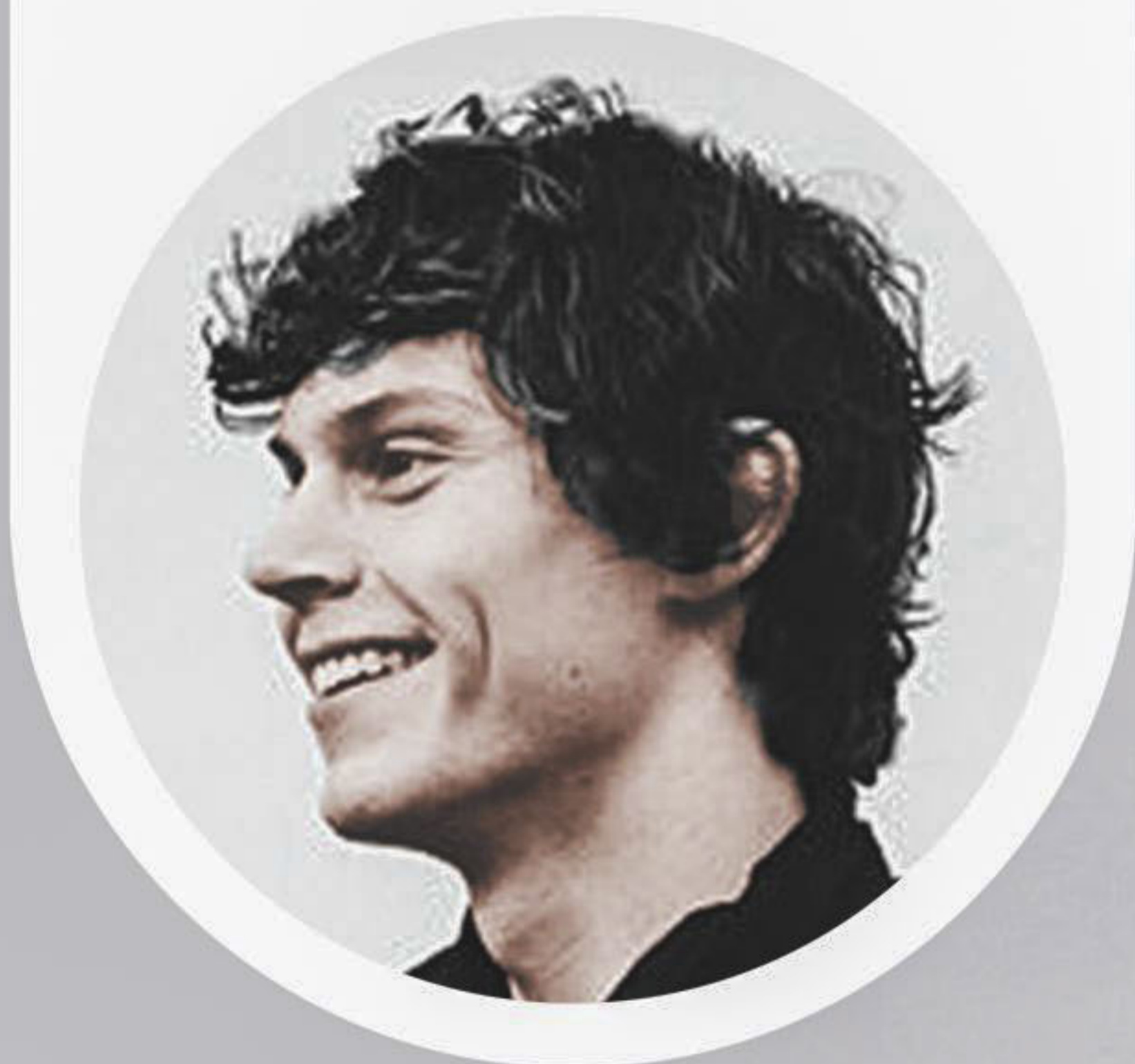


X-Men's Evan Peters joins cast of Elvis And Nixon

Evan Peters has been signed to star in the historical drama flick 'Elvis And Nixon.' The indie project, which already stars Kevin Spacey as President Nixon opposite Michael Shannon as Elvis Presley, was penned by actor Cary Elwes with Hanala and Joey Sagal, and would be helmed by Liza Johnson, Deadline.com reported.
