Man dies in furniture factory fire

The charred body of a man, whose identity is yet to be confirmed, was recovered from a tin-roofed furniture factory, most of which burned down after catching fire around 8:30pm in the capital's West Kazipara yesterday.

The source of the fire at Barmateak Furniture Ltd is yet to be known. It took one-and-a-half hours for firefighters from three stations to douse the flames.

5 held with hides of tiger, 5 deer

Rapid Action Battalion seized hides of a tiger and five deer and detained five people in this connection in the capital yesterday evening.

Based on their information, Rab detained the other two with the skin of the Bengal Tiger at a residence in Kalabagan, he said. The tiger might have been shot dead as there was a hole in its skin, he added.

3 die as trains hit them in Dhaka, Gazipur

In Gazipur, another unidentified man, aged around 35, was killed as another train hit him in Tongi area, said law enforcers.

HC begins hearing appeals in BDR carnage

A special High Court bench yesterday started hearing the death references and the appeals in the BDR carnage case, paving the way for complete adjudication of the biggest ever criminal case in the country's history in terms of the number of accused and convicts.

Attorney General Mahbubey Alam and Additional Attorney General Murad Reza read out from the first information report of the case before the three-member bench of the court.

After concluding the day's proceedings, the bench comprising Justice Md Shawkat Hossain, Justice Md Abu Zafor Siddique and Justice Nazrul Islam Talukder fixed today for resuming the hearing.

Earlier on Saturday, the newly appointed Chief Justice Surendra Kumar Sinha reconstituted the HC bench to include Justice Nazrul Islam Talukder in place of Justice Mustafa Zaman Islam.

On January 4, the then chief justice Md Muzammel Hossain had formed the bench, including Justice Mustafa, for hearing and disposing of the death references and the 257 appeals filed by the convicts.


A Dhaka court on November 5, 2013 awarded death penalty to 150 soldiers of the erstwhile Bangladesh Rifles (BDR) and two civilians, and sentenced 161 others to life imprisonment for their roles and involvement in the carnage.

It also handed down rigorous imprisonment, ranging from three to 10 years, to 256 people, mostly BDR soldiers. The court acquitted the remaining 277 accused. A total of 846 people, 823 of them BDR personnel, were on trial.

Seventy four people, including 57 army officials, were slain in the BDR mutiny on February 25-26 in 2009 at the Pilkhana headquarters in Dhaka. The paramilitary force was later renamed Border Guard Bangladesh.



Hasan shot 2 Hindu men dead in Kishoreganj

Forcefully buried them in a mass grave instead of allowing families to cremate them; desecrated icons of their deities, says septagenarian woman at International Crimes Tribunal-1 Ghosh, husband Nripendra Ranjan Ghosh and

A prosecution witness yesterday narrated how war crimes accused fugitive Syed Hasan Ali shot dead her father-in-law and a man from a neighbouring village and had the bodies buried with death threats while Razakars accompanying him desecrated pictures of Hindu deities at Araiura village of Kishoreganj during the Liberation War on October 8, 1971. During the attack on their house by Razakars, an

auxiliary force of the Pakistani occupation army, one introduced himself as "Hasan Daroga", the razakar commander of Tarail Thana, said the septuagenarian, Rekha Rani Ghosh.

"Razakar Hasan was wearing a khaki dress and had a white tupi (cap). He had a sharp-pointed beard. He was restless," she told International Crimes Tribunal-1.

The Razakars caught her father-in-law Kamini Kumar

them to the open yard, added Rekha. "There were portraits of many goddesses in our room. Hasan Razakar ordered other Razakars to bring the portraits down (from the

two sisters-in-law hiding inside and brought

walls)...Razakars threw the portraits before my

father-in-law and tread on those. "Hasan Daroga repeatedly asked my fatherin-law to urinate on those portraits but he did not do it. Hasan Daroga later demanded money from my father-in-law but he refused to give any," said Rekha.

Razakars then looted rice, money, gold ornaments and five cows, she added.

On Hasan's instruction, five to six Razakars brought Jibon Thakur from a neighbouring Chikni village and made SEE PAGE 5 COL 8
