Bring all killers of Ullash to book in 72 hours

Locals give the ultimatum at human chain on Lalmonirhat--Burimari highway

Locals formed a human chain on Lalmonirhat-Burimari Highway in Hatibandha upazila yesterday, demanding arrest and exemplary punishment of all the killers of schoolboy Ullash Islam.

Teachers and students of all educational institutions in the upazila and political and cultural activists joined the programme.

Hatibandha Upazila Chairman Liakat

Hossain Bachchu, principal of Hatibandha Women's College Shamsul Haque, Principal of Hatibandha Shishu Niketon Engineer Nazrul Islam, headmaster of Hatibandha SS High School and Technical College Rezaul Karim, headmaster of Shah Garibullah Girls' High School Tabibar Rahman, acting headmaster of Hatibandha Adarsha High School Mahatab Hossain, and local AL, BNP, JP leaders

spoke at a rally held on the highway near the upazila headquarters during the human chain programme.

The speakers demanded arrest of all the culprits involved in the abduction and killing of Ullash within 72 hours. Otherwise, they threaten to launch an agitation programme in the upazila.

Ullash, 6, son of vegetable trader Nuruzzaman Miah of Singimari village, was a class one student of Hatibandha Shishu

Niketan.

A gang abducted him on Monday afternoon and then phoned his father, demanding Tk one lakh ransom for release of his son.

At around 8:00pm, the abductors informed his family through SMS that Ullash was killed at an abandoned building of the upazila parishad.

Police have so far arrested six students of Hatibandha SS High School and Technical College, suspecting their involvement in the

Abducted student rescued

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab-5) rescued a student of Chapainawabganj Polytechnic Institute from Rehaichar area under Chapainawabganj municipality on Wednesday, a day after his abduction on Tuesday.

The elite force members also arrested one of the abductors, Fazle Rabbi Hridoy, 17, a student of the same institution and son of Abdus Salam of Moktarpur Bazar in Charghat upazila of Rajshahi.

Hridoy along with his other accomplices kidnapped Shakin Sarker, 16, son of Khasru Sarker of Hatem Khan area under Boalia Police Station in Rajshahi City Corporation, from his room at a students' mess on Tuesday around 4:00pm, said Major Kamruzzaman, commanding officer (CO) of Rab-5.

Later, the gang phoned the victim's mother and demanded Tk 2 lakh as ransom for her son's release. Around 7:45pm, they again phoned his mother and forced the family to send them Tk 15,000 instantly though a bKash number.

Immediately after sending the money, victim's father filed a case with Chapainawabganj Sadar Model Police Station and also informed Rab-5 to take necessary steps to rescue his son.

At around 7:50pm on Wednesday, a team of the law enforcers raided the area along the Mohananda River by tracking their phone calls. They arrested Rabbi from the spot and rescued Shakin.

Robbers open fire on villagers, 1 killed

A man was killed and three others were injured as armed robbers opened fire on the villagers at Bhadrasan village in Shibchar upazila of the district early yesterday.

The deceased was identified as Jahangir Hossain Bepari, 30, son of Aziz Bepari.

Police quoted witnesses as saying that a gang of 15/20 robbers entered the house of one Anil Saha by breaking open the door at around 2:30am and beat up the family members.

The gang confined Anil, a grocer, and his family members to a room and looted cash, gold ornaments and other valuables.

Hearing screams, neighbours rushed to the spot and surrounded the house. Sensing the presence of the robbers, the robbers opened, leaving Jahangir, his father and two others injured.

As bullet-hit Jahangir fell to the ground, the gang stabbed him and fled the scene with the booty. Jahangir died on the spot. The rest three were admitted to Shibchar Upazila Health Complex.

Being informed, police rushed to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to Madaripur Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Police yesterday arrested Shahidul Islam, a resident of the village, suspecting his involvement in the robbery,

said Abu Bakkar, Assistant superintendent of police.

Our Noakhali correspondent adds: Robbers looted a house at Baliakandi village in Senbagh upazila early yesterday.

The injured are Md Riaz 28 and Md Salam 25. They are undergoing treatment at the upazila health complex.

House owner Md Nur Islam, said a gang of 10 to 12 robbers entered his house breaking the collapsible gate at around 2:00am. As the family members cried for help, the gang stabbed Riaz and Salam, sons of Nur Islam, and looted 22 tolas of gold ornaments, Tk five lakh, four mobile sets and other valuables.

A case was filed with the police in this connection.

Husband confesses to wife's murder before court

Both husband and brother-in-law on Wednesday confessed to the killing of Rina Begum in Kalapara upazila of the district over a month ago.

They gave statements before a court under Section 164, said Md Azizur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Kalapara Police Station.

After recording their statements, Senior Judicial Magistrate Swapan Kumar Das sent the deceased's husband Rashed Khan, 40, and brother-in-law Haider Khan to jail in the evening.

Police arrested the two in Khurier Khaya ghat area under Amtali upazila of Barguna district on Tuesday. The arrestees hail from Goimatala village in Kalapara upazila.

On December 24 last year, the law enforcers recovered the body of Rina, 32, daughter of late Kanu Sheikh of Badebihali village in Nagorpur upazila of Tangail district, from a

paddy field in Mostafapur area under Kalapara, said the OC.

According to their confessional statements, before marriage, Rashed, Haider and Rina worked at a garment factory in Dhaka.

Rina had Tk 5 lakh in a bank account and post office. To make quick buck, Rashed developed a relationship with Rina and finally married her.

After their wedding, Rashed somehow took all the money from Rina. They often engaged in altercation as Rina demanded the money from him.

As a sequel to the conflict, Rashed and Haider hatched a plan to kill Rina. According to the plan, the duo on December 23 took Rina to Mostafapur area in Kalapara, saying they would visit their village home.

At midnight, they hacked Rina to death and dumped the body in the paddy field. Rashed and Haider went into hiding after the incident, said police.

Child marriage bid foiled, two jailed

A mobile court sentenced two people to one month's imprisonment for arranging marriage of an underage girl at Baraghariya village in Aditmari upazila on Wednesday.

The convicts are bridegroom Laizu Miah, 24, son of Wahab Ali of Uttarpara village, and bride's grandfather Jasim Uddin, 65, of Baraghariya in the upazila.

Police said Mazeda Khataun, 14, daughter of Javed Ali of Baraghariya village and a student of Class VI of DS Dakhil Madrasa in the area, was set to be married with Laizu on Wednesday night.

Being informed, a police team, led by Upazila Nirbahi Officer Zahurul Islam, rushed to the spot, arrested the two and stopped the marriage.

However, the parents of the bride and bridegroom managed to flee, sensing the presence of the team.
