28 burnt in city bus arson

Condition of 9 stated critical

In one of the worst arson attacks on public transport, at least 28 people suffered burns as two petrol bombs thrown by suspected blockaders exploded inside a bus at the capital's Jatrabari last night.

Most of the passengers got their faces and necks burnt and suffered inhalation inju-

Nine victims -- one with 48 percent and others with more than 15 percent burns -were in critical condition while the rest suffered 3-15pc burns, burn treatment expert Dr Samanta Lal Sen said.

"Nobody appears out of danger," he told reporters at Dhaka Medical College and Hospital.

An estimated 36 to 42 people were on the bus, owned by Glory Express Private Ltd. Before this arson, two other vehicles -- a bus and human hauler -- came under petrol bomb attack, leaving one injured.

The only woman victim was Syed Fatema, 24, a pharmacist travelling with her husband. Her chest, back and neck were burnt.

As victims were brought to the hospital, it turned out to be the worst attack in terms of the number of people injured in a single incident since the countrywide blockade began on January 6.

The hospital struggled to cope with the situation as the victims came in phases. Starting from 9:45pm, the number of patients rose steadily, from 6 to 11 to 17 to 21 to 24 to 28 until 11:45pm. Several hundred people, including the

victims' relatives, thronged the hospital after the news spread. Along the corridor on the ground floor some were wailing while some wept silently.

"We hate our two leaders," shouted out a Dhaka College student, whose brother and sister-in-law were among the victims. "They SEE PAGE 11 COL 2

Yet another bloody day sees 2 killed

8 including women, kids burnt as 'Shibir men' torch bus in Rajshahi; police-escorted truck attacked

Two more lives were lost and at least 43 people were burnt yesterday as arson attacks on vehicles continued across the country on the 18th day of the indefinite blockade enforced by the BNP-led alliance.

Taking the death toll to 30 in the violence since January 5, a truck helper and a CNG-run auto-rickshaw driver died yesterday in attacks by blockade supporters.

Apart from the gruesome bus arson in the capital that burned at least 28 people, eight more including three women and two children were burnt as a bus was fire-bombed in

Rajshahi last night.

In another incident, alleged blockaders threw Molotov cocktails on a truck escorted by four policemen in Moulvibazar, leaving the driver's assistant critically burnt.

According to fire service officials, at least eight vehicles were torched across the country yesterday.

Meanwhile, a 13-year-old boy who was burnt under unclear circumstances in Savar

Rice goes up by Tk 3 a kg

Blockade upsets supply to Dhaka, Ctg

Rice prices are going up in the two major · cities -- Dhaka and Chittagong -- as the BNP-led alliance's nationwide blockade · continues to disrupt supply.

Prices of all types of rice have risen by up to Tk 3 a kg in both wholesale and retail markets in the two cities, home to over two crore people, though the prices · remain unchanged at milling hubs.

Wary wholesalers refrained from bringing supplies for fear of arson attacks on

highways while their stocks of rice run low. "We have to charge higher prices for the
